



All Souls' Day

Today is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, more commonly known as All Souls' Day. While not a Holy Day of Obligation like yesterday's Feast of All Saints, a day focused on the Church in Heaven, this is a day of holy opportunity to remember the souls of some of the departed, the Church in Purgatory.

We already commemorate the dead at every single Mass, as part of the Eucharistic prayer, and you will hear these words again today. But today's feast gives us a chance to reflect in a special way, not so much on the dead, but on we who are left behind to live this moment. Today's celebration reminds us that each one of us has moved one day closer to death. It's our common destiny.

The topic may sound morbid, but in fact it contains a secret to tremendous joy. And our faith has a direct impact on how we face this ultimate moment. As a priest, I have the chance to participate in many funerals, and I can tell you I have noticed a tremendous difference in the kinds of funerals we celebrate. Where there is little or no active faith in the deceased or the family of the deceased, the funeral experience is really quite morbid, gloomy, and despairing.

But when there is faith present, a living and active faith, the atmosphere is quite different: there is sadness, yes, but the mood is much lighter - more confident, even flashes of joy. Death is an acknowledgement of human frailty. It shows the transient nature of life on earth. For us Christians, death is not the end of life but the beginning of a new life. We are not going from life to death but from life to eternity.

At the same time, we believe that due to our human weakness and sins we are unable to help ourselves when we die. The souls in purgatory, being unable to help themselves, depend solely on the supplications of the saints in heaven and of the faithful who are still on earth.

That is one reason why the Church has set apart this day to honor the members suffering in purgatory. Therefor, this is a day specially set apart for us to remember and pray for our dear ones who have gone to their eternal reward, and who are currently in a state of ongoing purification.

Saint Augustine remarked that he used to pray for his deceased mother, remembering her request, "when I die, bury me anywhere you like, but remember to pray for me at the altar."
