# Saints Peter and Paul Parish



With the disease of leprosy highlighted in both the first reading and the Gospel, I had the same thought I had in the past when they come up...*Ben-Hur*. For some reason my dad loved this movie. Perhaps it was the elaborate sets, the famous chariot races or the amazing soundtrack of the film that enamored my dad. He would routinely play the soundtrack from this movie which won 11 Academy awards. I know now it was the connection

to Christ that was a major factor in his love of the film. My memories of *Ben-Hur are* that golden album cover, the scenes with the lepers.

This time, when I read and reflected on the readings, something else came to mind. This time I thought about this old man who lived a few doors down from me when I was a kid. I never knew his name, just the lousy nickname someone gave him which stuck. I never saw anyone stop to talk to him. He lived a quiet, solitary life, and the reason was always plain to see: the large, visible lesions on his face. When he passed by, people instinctively looked away, crossed the street, or fell silent. Kids, me included, would stare or run. Some yelled things at him. The man, though a resident of our modern, bustling community, lived as an outcast—a modern echo of a very ancient sorrow.

My perception of his isolation connected my thoughts to *Ben-Hur*. The film vividly depicts what happens when sickness becomes a sentence of social death. In one of the most poignant subplots, Judah Ben-Hur's mother, Miriam, and his sister, Tirzah, contract leprosy. Their despair is so profound that they willingly exile themselves to the Valley of the Lepers. They hide even from their beloved Judah, believing that their rotting flesh makes them "unclean" and unworthy of love. The valley is not just a place of disease; it is a geographic manifestation of society's fear and rejection. Their fate—to be shunned and hidden—is the ultimate horror, a complete loss of dignity and belonging. I fear much like my old neighbor.

This isolation points directly to the spiritual lesson in the Gospel story of the Ten Lepers. They, too, were defined entirely by their affliction. Forced to stand "at a distance," they could only lift their voices in a collective, desperate plea: "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" They weren't asking for medicine; they were asking for a miracle that would restore them to their families, their homes, and their lives. And all ten were granted that miracle. They were made whole. But the story doesn't end with the healing. It ends with a moment of critical reflection: Only one of the ten returned to say "thank you".

The old man in my neighborhood, Miriam and Tirzah in their hidden valley, and the nine ungrateful lepers all teach us about the two sides of affliction:

- 1. The Pain of the Outcast: They remind us that the deepest suffering of disease is often the isolation and shame imposed by others. They are the ones we avoid, the ones we allow to live on the margins.
- 2. The Duty of the Healed: The one grateful Samaritan, an ethnic outcast himself, reminds us that health and wholeness—whether physical or social—are profound gifts. He is the only one who didn't just walk away with his new life, but paused to acknowledge the source of his blessing.

When I think of that old man now, and I am sure he has long passed away, I try to remember the Samaritan. We his neighbors, know we could not offer him a miraculous cure, but we could have recognized his humanity. Perhaps the modern-day miracle isn't the healing of the flesh, but the healing of the spirit—the conscious choice to offer compassion rather than avoidance, and to pause in gratitude for all the blessings that allow us to live within the community walls.

The questions the Gospel asks is eternal: When the miracle of wholeness happens, whether for us or for those around us, where are the other nine? And which one are we?
