NOTE: If you are registering a child for the first time, no matter the level, we are required to collect a copy of the Certificate of Baptism. If your child was baptized at St's Peter and Paul Parish, then just indicate below and our office will be able to obtain the certificate. If a child is not baptized and over the age of 7, please contact the RelEd office. In the diocese of Camden, children are recommended to complete 8 years of Religious Instruction with 2 years of preparation prior to the reception of Penance/Communion and Confirmation with Communion/Penance occurring at the conclusion of level 2 and Confirmation following the completion of level 8. In addition, and as part of Faith Formation, families should attend 6 Family Catechetical Gatherings per year. The reception of Sacraments also requires additional preparation outside of religious instruction, which may include meetings, catechetical sessions, retreats, prayer experiences and gatherings. It is also important to note that all children enrolled in faith formation should fulfill their moral obligation to attend Mass regularly on Sundays (Saturday evening vigil Mass) and holy days of obligation.

Important information regarding children with Specific learning disciplines, photo release agreement and photo sharing.

Children with Specific Home-Based Catechetical Needs: All children are welcomed into the Religious Education Programs. Accommodation can be made to help in each child's learning discipline. Parents with children not able to be incorporated among typical learners, but who wish to have them participate in religious instruction and prepare to receive Sacraments must contact the office to discuss the options available.

Photo Release Agreement for Newsletter, Web-Site and Media Promotional: *By enrolling your child in the St.'s Peter & Paul Parish Faith formation Program you hereby give the Diocese of Camden, its successors and assigns and those acting with its authority, which is to include the St.'s Peter and Paul Parish (SPP,) the unqualified right and permission to reproduce, copyright, publish, circulate or otherwise use any SPP pictures, videos, sound recordings or other media promotional of your child(ren) produced by the Diocese of Camden. You further understand that our SPP Program may be identified by name and agree that this is a complete release of all claims against the Diocese of Camden its successors and assigns and those acting with its authority, which is to include the aforementioned.*

Children in photos or on live meets must be properly dressed, meaning fully clothed, and must have the consent of the parent/guardian and the child for their image to be shared.*

St.'s Peter & Paul Fall-Spring Program Registration -

1. The Fall-Spring Faith Formation for children is for the purpose of providing a complete year of instructional study (aka: CCD -*Confraternity of Christian Doctrine*-.) This program is offered weekly on Tuesday evenings. It is crucial that children attending Faith Formation make every effort to fully participate in all sessions. All units must be satisfactorily completed in order that the child complies with the diocesan required full year of Religious Instruction. We use the Alive in Christ print and digital text for the typical levels 1 – 8.
2. **All families with children in the Faith Formation Program must abide by the following:**
 - a. **Children must make every effort to attend and arrive on time** – Faith Formation is offered on Tuesday evenings at the Parish Hall from 4:30-5:30pm. Please follow the schedule provided. Children should be **dropped off** at the front doors. All children must be accompanied by an adult.
 - b. **Children must be picked up** at the Parish Hall, unless otherwise instructed, at 5:30pm. Parents may gather at the front doors. Once classes have concluded, parents will be able to go to the classroom door for pick-up.
 - c. **Children must have with them** their student book, notebook, and pencil/pen.
3. **Family Catechetical Gatherings (FCG)** is a major component of the Faith Formation program - therefore families are to attend 6 family catechetical gatherings, throughout the Fall to Spring Faith Formation year. These gatherings and their format will be made available as soon as they are scheduled. These gatherings are part of the diocesan requirement. Please make sure to let the office know if your family is not able to attend the gathering in order that other arrangements may be made. The purpose of these gatherings is to help with the review of catechetical materials, faith sharing and formation, and help to strengthen the domestic church. Meals or snacks may be provided. Children must NOT attend alone. Sunday liturgy and holy days of obligation are not counted as part of the 6 family catechetical gatherings. Though social events are great for building up community, they too are not considered part of FGC. Instead, prayer experiences such Stations of the Cross, Parish Reconciliation Services, Parish Missions, etc. are more appropriately applied to this diocesan requirement.

Please note that this is not an exhaustive list and there may be updates and changes as the year goes on.

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
