



The Pastor's Corner Brothers and Sisters,

There is a story about two shopkeepers in a small village. One was known for his honesty, he gave customers full measure, charged fair prices, and treated everyone with respect. People trusted him, even if his store was simple and modest. The other shopkeeper often cheated, he used false weights, inflated prices, and tried to take advantage of those in need. For a time, it seemed the dishonest man was richer and more successful. But little by little, people discovered the truth. Customers stopped going to him, and his wealth could not buy back the trust he had lost. The honest man, meanwhile, kept his good name and the peace of heart that comes with this Sunday, as we hear the Gospel of the

dishonest steward, we are reminded that choices matter, whether they are rooted in dishonesty or integrity.

Today, on the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel presents us with a parable that carries an important lesson for our daily lives. In the Gospels, when Jesus tells a story or a parable, what truly matters is what Scripture scholars call the point of the parable, the essential message the story is meant to highlight.

Here, the point of the parable is very clear. Jesus praises the dishonest steward, not for his dishonesty, but for his boldness and skill in responding to the situation. "The master commended the dishonest steward for his prudence" (Luke 16:8). Jesus does not approve of his wrongdoing, but he highlights the steward's decisiveness in acting while he still had the chance to prepare for the future.

This is a lesson for all disciples of Jesus. We too must decide to follow him with courage, even in difficult circumstances. "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you" (Deuteronomy 31:6). We are only passing through this world as we await his glorious return. Our future is at stake today, for eternal life has already begun. Jesus reminds us: "Lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in and steal" (Matthew 6:20).

This same message is echoed in the first reading, where the prophet Amos condemns those who exploit and oppress others for selfish gain. God declares: "I will never forget anything they have done" (Amos 8:7). Such people will be deprived of his presence.

We have reflected briefly on this challenging parable of Jesus. It must be received in the right spirit. The message is clear: "No one can serve two masters... You cannot serve both God and mammon" (Luke 16:13). Choosing to follow Jesus is the most important decision of our lives. This choice is renewed every Sunday in the Eucharist. Despite our weaknesses, we can say to Jesus: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life" (John 6:68).

He hears us when we ask forgiveness during the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass—when we say, "Lord, have mercy." Then he gives himself to us in his Word, and in his Body and Blood, strengthening us for the path we have chosen with boldness and determination.

Together, let us remain faithful to Christ with courage and love, renewing our "yes" to Him each day.
