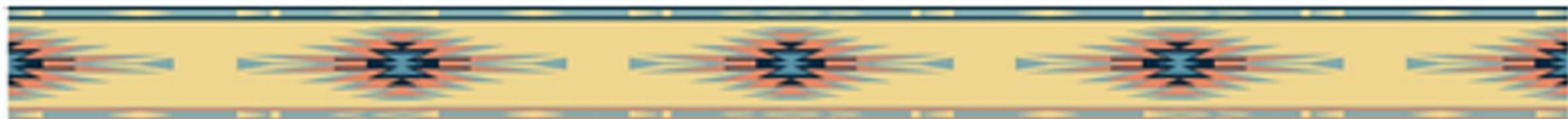

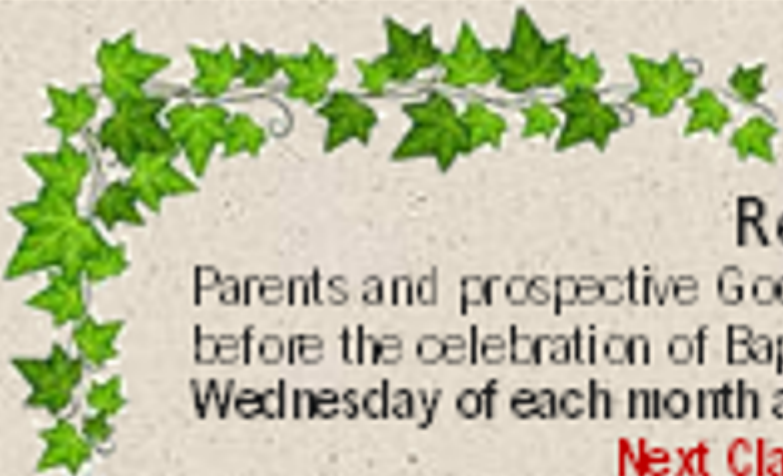

A WELCOME THAT HAS NO BORDERS

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

August 16, 2026

Dear Parishioners of Holy Angels and St. Charles,

Today's readings give us a beautiful reminder that **God's love has no borders**. God does not look at where we come from, what our background is, or what mistakes we have made. He looks at the heart that seeks Him.

In today's Gospel, a Canaanite woman comes to Jesus with a heart full of faith and a desperate prayer: **"Lord, help me."** She is an outsider. She is not one of the people who traditionally followed Jesus. Yet she refuses to give up. Even when Jesus seems silent, she continues to trust. Even when others might have told her to go away, she remains at His feet. And finally Jesus says to her: **"O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish."**

What a beautiful message for us today. Sometimes we come to Jesus with the same prayer: **"Lord, help me."** We may be carrying worries about our children, our families, our health, our finances, our relationships, or our future. Sometimes we pray and God seems silent. Sometimes we wonder if He has heard us.

The Canaanite woman teaches us: **Do not give up. Keep praying. Keep trusting. Keep coming to Jesus.** Her faith reminds us that God hears the cry of every person. The prophet Isaiah tells us that God's house is meant to be **"a house of prayer for all peoples."** That means there is room at God's table for everyone.

As members of Holy Angels and St. Charles, may we become people who make others feel that same welcome. May our churches be places where people who are hurting find comfort, people who are searching find faith, people who feel forgotten find friendship, and people who have wandered away find their way home.

Our faith is not only about coming to church; it is about becoming the face, hands, and heart of Jesus to one another.

And today I want to leave you with one simple prayer:

"Lord Jesus, help me."

When life is difficult, pray it.

When you are afraid, pray it.

When your family is struggling, pray it.

When you feel alone, pray it.

When you don't know what to do, pray it.

And when life is filled with blessings, pray it with gratitude.

Jesus never tires of hearing the sincere cry of a faithful heart.
