Al-Anon Family Groups

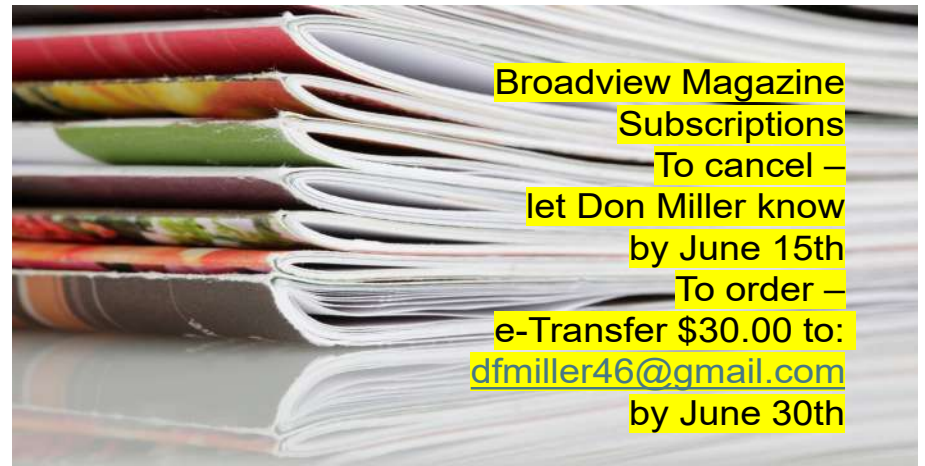
