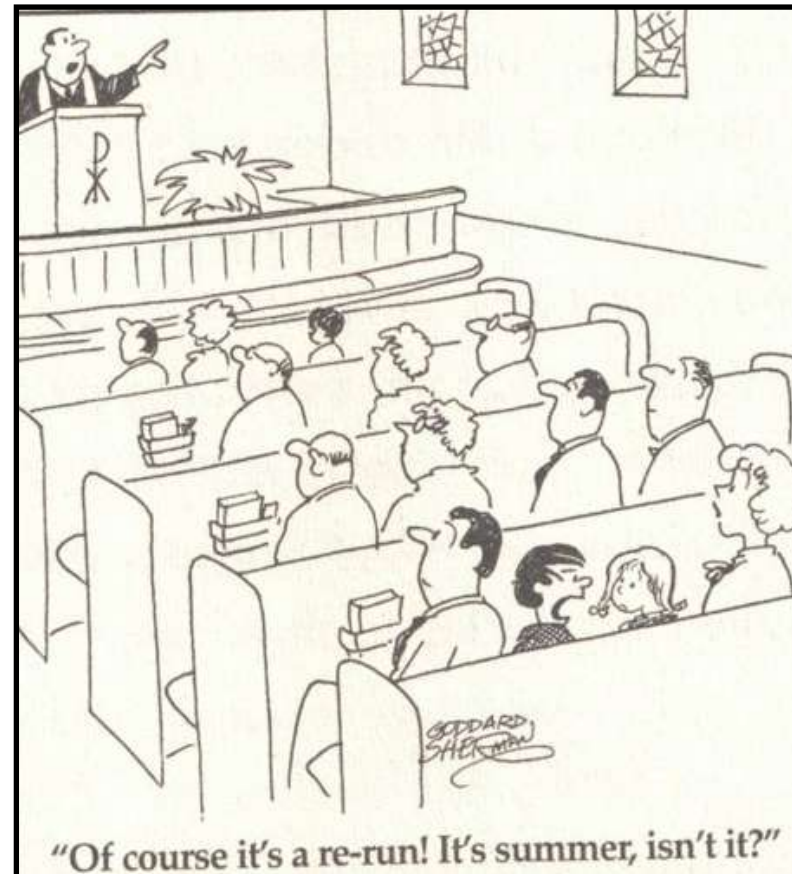
Acknowledgement of the Land
