Camden Golf Club (Studley Park) at Narellan is one of the most pleasurable golf courses on which you can play.



# A Brief History

Camden Golf Club Ltd was established in 1950 at its permanent site at Studley Park having occupied several sites in and around Camden from the 1930s.

The Club has a rich history, and the land on which it stands arguably even more so. First-time visitors to Camden Golf Club cannot help but notice the magnificent building within the grounds.

This property is known as Studley Park House, the building of which was commissioned in 1888 by prominent businessman William Charles Payne.

It is thought Payne named the property "Studley Park" after a property near where his father-inlaw lived at Ripon in England. But the building of Studley Park House left Payne heavily in debt and he was forced to sell the property to Francis Buckle, the architect of the house, in 1891.

Studley Park House became the Camden Grammar School in 1902 and continued to operate as a school until 1933 when the school closed. It was sold for \$4,900 to Arthur Gregory, Sales Manager of Twentieth Century Fox, who went about refurbishing the house in the Art Deco style.




Gregory was a keen golfer and commissioned Eric Apperly to design a 9-hole course for Studley Park. A further nine holes were added at a later date.

Apperly was regarded as one of the most preeminent golf course architects of the day in New South Wales. He was no mean amateur golfer, either, winning the NSW Amateur Championships five times and, most famously of all, the Australian Amateur Championship in 1920.

Studley Park House, meanwhile, was acquired by the Army during World War II at a cost of \$16,000 and used as a School of Tactical Instruction. One of its first students was Lieutenant A R Cutler, who later became the Governor of NSW.

The end of the war saw a decline in the use of Studley Park and in 1949 a group of local residents approached the Army and secured a 10-year lease on all but 18 acres (containing Studley Park House and its surrounds) for use as a golf club.

The stables were converted for use as the clubhouse and Camden Golf Club Ltd had a magnificent new home. In 1958 major extensions were added to the clubhouse and further work was completed in 1973.

The lease was extended a number of times and in 1992 the Federal Government agreed to sell the land to Camden Golf Club Limited on a 99-year lease, which was finally signed in 1995.

Camden Golf Club purchased Studley Park House in 1996, thereby bringing the entire property under its control.

The house was sold to a private owner in 2009, Camden Council having purchased the golf course property from the Commonwealth three years earlier.

This latter move in no way affected the Club's rights under its existing lease.

Camden Golf Club celebrated its 50th anniversary at Studley Park in 2000. Since 2003 major renovations to the golf course have occurred in accordance with an overall course master plan.




# Camden Golf Club's 75th Anniversary Celebrations

The evening was a fitting tribute to 75 years of camaraderie, achievement, and community spiri at Camden Golf Club.




# The Course

Camden Golf Club has a real gem of a golf course that will delight everyone from the experienced golf professional to the casual player. The course is a 5,893-metre par-71 test for men, with three par-3s and two par-5s on the outward nine and one par-3 and one par-5 coming home. Women play a no-less-enthralling par-74 layout measuring 5,373 metres, benefiting from extra shots on two of the tougher par-4s on the card for the men, the 7th and 14th, while the new 9th is a challenging par 3 for men and a reachable par 4 for women.


It is a great course that all categories and standards of golfer will enjoy playing which is testament to a great design, with multiple teeing positions presenting the opportunity for players of all ability to truly test their game.

There are exciting carries over water, and some cunningly-placed bunkers, both around the green and in the fairways, which give players some crucial decisions to make on club selection.



The course has benefited from substantial investment in recent years, with several holes being remodelled and landscaped and work being carried out to improve the bunkers. Add that to the truerunning nature of the putting surfaces and this is a golfing challenge to relish!

Even on the days when the putts are refusing to drop, there are the stunning views to the distant Blue Mountains and the iconic Studley Park House to be enjoyed.



# Course Tour

We hope you enjoy your time with us at Camden Golf Club. Here are a few useful tips and course notes which should help you make the most of your round if you have never visited us before.



### Hole 1, 355 Metres, Par 4

Setting us out on our way is a dogleg left hole. The drive needs to be straight or with slight draw (for the right-handers) to negotiate past the gums before the fairway widens out. Aim for the 100m marker or distant church steeple (St. Johns in Camden) and pray you don't err left as out of bounds and trees are waiting for a hooked drive. Around the green there should be no problem, unless you miss to the right where a gentle slope will see your ball run back to your feet.

#### Hole 2, 288 Metres, Par 4

A risk/reward hole. Lay up – or take it on. This has two fairway bunkers strategically placed at the dogleg. A big drive must be accurate to avoid trouble on the left side of this hole.

#### Hole 3, 156 Metres, Par 3

This green is larger in size and surrounded by bunkers waiting to capture any stray shot. Too much club and you are in the back bunker. Pull the ball slightly left and you are out of bounds. Hit to the right and the ball runs that way into trouble. Another risk/reward hole. Take it on or lay up and chip on. Putting on this green is challenging.

#### Hole 4, 520 Metres, Par 5

Your drive needs to be long and accurate to pass through the two bunkers guarding the fairway edges. The right-hand side is protected by a heavily-wooded area which follows the fairway to the 100-metre mark. Be aware that if your ball crosses the access road on the right of the fairway you are out of bounds. A dam which lines most of the left side of this hole will capture a hooked shot and the inclusion of another set of fairway bunkers awaits your second shot. Your course management skills will be tested before approaching the green that is protected by bunkers front and right and a pond to the left. Finish up too far from the pin and it's three-putt territory.

### Hole 5, 362 Metres, Par 4

The hole bends slightly left and you are presented with water in front of the tee. In your enthusiasm to get over it, don't be too pumped up to drive the ball too hard, as another dam awaits you in the distance. Watch the poplars on the left and the road beyond. Your second will be an iron to an elevated green with sand left and a difficult green to hold. Out of bounds comes in close on this side too so play for safety right of the flag, noting the target is quite small. Shortish in length but a par is an excellent result.

### Hole 6, 153 Metres, Par 3

If the wind isn't blowing this shorter hole shouldn't present too many problems. The side to miss the green is to the left. There is a bunker on the right and should you miss this green the up and down is a real challenge.

### Hole 7, 388 Metres, Par 4

One of the hardest holes on the course. As you spy the green in the distance the big gum on the right is your target, allowing the fairway to bring your ball back to the centre. Gum trees and fescue on the left mean you must aim at the righthand side of the fairway. When playing to the green play long or right for a possible recovery. This takes the left bunker, out of bounds and deep rough out of play.

#### Hole 8, 493 Metres, Par 5

This is one of the newly designed holes. From the tee hit over the ditch to the right of centre towards the mounds on this side. Watch the large trees left of the fairway that run to the green and the gardens that if found require you to play your next shot without relief. Lay up to 100 metres out to get the most ideal approach to a wide, narrow in depth and undulating green. Beware the dam front left of the approach. Overclub here and the back pot will be the next challenge. Tough hole.

#### Hole 9, 202 Metres, Par 3

Another of the newly designed holes, and what a tough new addition. Rated number 1 on the indexes, a long uphill tee shot to a large undulating green protected by two deep bunkers. Watch out for the out of bounds right and the trees left. Par here will be a tremendous result.

### Hole 10, 351 Metres, Par 4

This slight dog-leg right requires a set-up left of centre. Bark areas left of the fairway and significant trouble on the right make for a difficult tee shot. Overhanging trees on the left-hand side mean your approach to the green is a difficult shot. Once on the green, a slope from back to front and right to left makes for a tough putt.

### Hole 11, 351 Metres, Par 4

Even though this presents itself as a straightforward hole, water runs along the right and trees run along the left guarding two large native grass mounds in your driving zone. There is no relief from these mounds as your second shot to


the green needs to be accurate with two traps right and one back left. The ditch comes into play here also. Watch your placement on this sloping green as position is key for a chance to one-putt. One of the more demanding putting surfaces on the course.

### Hole 12, 280 Metres, Par 4

Another of the recent changes to the course. Now a par 4, this hole is a risk reward hole. Load up with the driver and the hole could be a simple birdie. Make a mistake and you could be in the ditch, the water or a difficult greenside bunker. Play it safe and a par 4 is an expected result. The green is very undulating and has many difficult pin placements.

### Hole 13, 341 Metres, Par 4

This hole is one of the features of the course. It is beautifully designed, requiring a good tee shot to clear the dam and offering a risk/reward for the big hitter. Your approach shot is to a much larger green guarded by two deep bunkers. You must hit this green or face a chip shot to an elevated position.

### Hole 14, 383 Metres, Par 4

One of the harder holes with moundings on the edge of the dam narrowing the fairway considerably. Left is water, right are trees so aim to be long and central for any chance of being on the green for two. The two-tiered green is the newest on the course and guarded by a bunker at the front right. Overhit your approach shot and you have a major problem as you don't want to be chipping back to this green that slopes from back to front.

#### Hole 15, 380 Metres, Par 4

A long hole with trees ready to play pinball with your shot on the right or left. Watch the bunker to the left of the green that catches many a ball hit this way. The safer side to miss is definitely right. It is easy to three-putt this green.

#### Hole 16, 159 Metres, Par 3

The prevailing wind is nearly always into your face for the tee shot. A dam that lies short and to the right of the green needs to be carried. Anything short is likely to finish there, so take an extra club.

### Hole 17, 494 Metres, Par 5

The second-last hole is the second-longest on the course. Hitting uphill from the tee, keep the ball right of centre to avoid cleverly-placed traps. Your second shot may require a hit over the bunkers and, if you wimp out to the left, another bunker awaits. The final shot into this par 5 is to a relatively small green that demands accuracy from your approach as a bunker is lying in wait to capture any loose shot.

#### Hole 18, 249 Metres, Par 4

If you can launch one over the trees on the left-hand side you could make this green in one, but on this hole many a golfer has lost the "title" going for the big drive. Out of bounds lurks left and long, whilst the last 70 metres (Heartbreak Hill) of this lovely finishing hole is uphill. If your second shot is short it will frustratingly roll back to your feet! A greenside trap on the right catches many who go through the fairway with their drive.

Women enjoy a similar annual series for the Jean Derrin Trophy, and our Camden Cup 18- hole event for women, also in May, forms part of this.



# "Have you thought about the Age pension lately?"

The other day I was chatting with a mate over coffee, and we ended up talking about something a lot of us try not to think too hard about — retirement. More specifically, the Age Pension. And even if you only qualify for a part pension, it can open the door to a bunch of other benefits — like discounts on healthcare, utilities, and public transport. What I usually say is: don't self-assess. That's what I'm here for. I can sit down with you, go over your situation, and help you figure out what you might be entitled to. No jargon, no pressure — just a straight-up chat.

So if you've ever wondered, "Am I eligible for the Age Pension?" or "Should I be doing something now to prepare?"—let's have that chat. You might be surprised.







Go through 1 roundabout and after 200m you will see the entrance to Camden Golf Club on your left.
