Enrollment Up Through Congregational Participation

Student engagement and church member enrolment remain strong as we move through March, reflecting continued enthusiasm for learning and discipleship across our congregations. Current enrolment stands at approximately 68 students, with additional registrations still being received.

In addition to *Samuel and Kings*, which began earlier in the term, *Biblical Preaching 1* is underway and continues to welcome participants. *Old Testament World* and *Understanding Culture—Engaging People* are also in progress, with *Servant Skills for Every Christian* scheduled to begin in May.

With students anticipated in the remaining course, total enrolment this school year could reach approximately 90—an encouraging milestone made possible through active congregational participation and support.

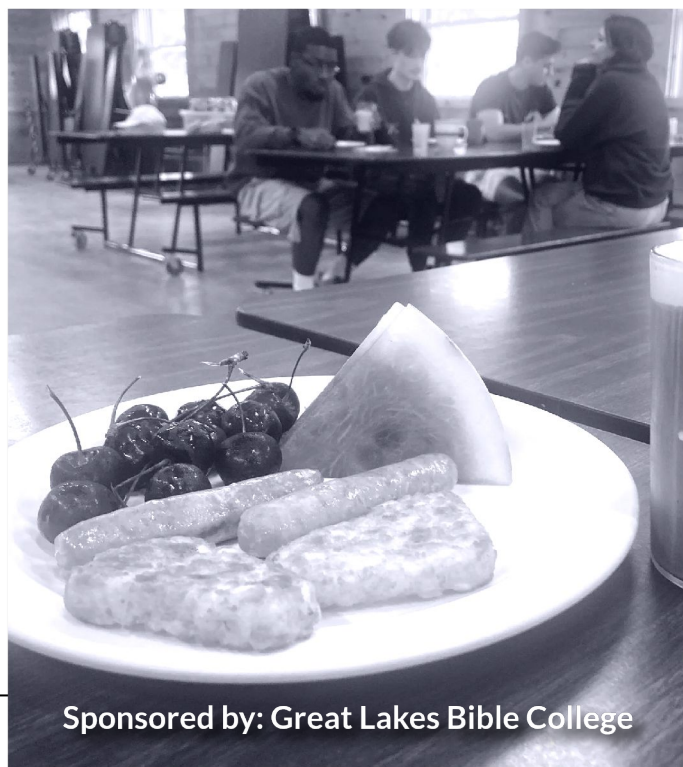

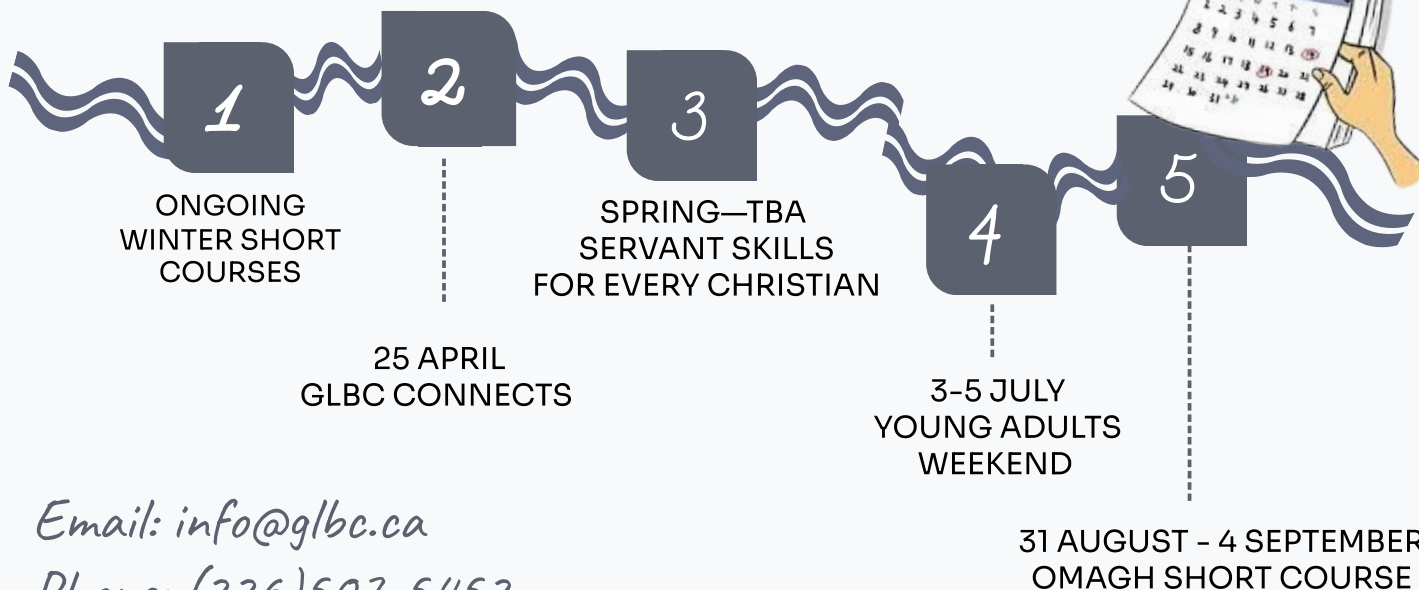
