Keep your song short and strong.

Your audition song should be no longer than **one minute** — choose a section that really shows off your voice and personality. *If it goes a little over, don't stress!* We just want to make sure everyone has time to shine.

Headshot time!

We'll take your **headshot** at auditions, so come camera-ready with your best smile and confident posture.

Show your energy and heart.

When you sing and act, bring lots of energy and emotion! Show us your passion for performing and how you connect with your character.
