As a former youth at Boys Town, I know firsthand what it feels like to need guidance, stability, and people who truly believe in you. Boys Town helped shape me into the man I am today. Because of that foundation, I was able to graduate successfully from Brooklyn, New York, and make the decision to stay in Nebraska after graduating in 2020. Since then, I have been on my own—working full-time while going to school full-time—building a future that once felt uncertain.

Currently, I am completing my prerequisites at Metropolitan Community College in preparation for the LPN program. In August 2026, I will begin my nursing program at Methodist. Becoming a nurse has been my dream for years. My mother was a nurse, and watching her care for others inspired me deeply. Nursing is not just a career to me—it is a calling. I want to be in a position where I can help people during some of the most vulnerable moments of their lives, just like others once helped me during mine.

Balancing work and school has not been easy. Living independently in Nebraska without family support

means that every bill, every textbook, and every tuition payment falls on me. This scholarship would relieve a significant financial burden and allow me to focus more fully on my studies and clinical training. Instead of worrying about how I will afford the next semester, I could dedicate that energy toward becoming the best nurse possible. It would bring me one step closer to earning my LPN, and eventually my BSN.

I believe I should receive this scholarship not only because of my financial need, but because of my commitment to growth and giving back. Boys Town invested in me when I needed it most. I have stayed out of trouble, remained focused, and continued pushing toward higher education. My long-term goal is to give back in a meaningful way—hopefully even working at Boys Town Hospital one day, whether as an LPN or after earning my BSN. I want to serve the same community that helped build me.

Everything Boys Town has done for me has led me to this point. This scholarship would not just support my education—it would help me fulfill a dream that started years ago. I am determined, disciplined, and grateful. With continued support, I will not only succeed, but I will come back and help others do the same.
