

**Madison Arts Barn
COVID & ILLNESS Policies
Applicable to Everyone Including, but Not Limited to,
Employees, Volunteers and Participants
Updated January 6, 2024**

1. Entry Policy:

- a. Upon entry please notify us if you have any cold or COVID symptoms.
- b. If you have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last ten days
 - i. Regardless of vaccination status you may not enter the Barn for at least 5 days from testing positive or not until you are fever-free* for at least 24 hrs, whichever is later.
- c. If you have been in close contact with someone who has been confirmed to have COVID.
 - i. You can enter the building but will need to wear a mask for 5 days from exposure. It is strongly recommended to take an “at home” antigen test or a PCR test 5 days after exposure.
- d. If you have had a fever* of 100.4F, vomited or had diarrhea in the last 24 hours you may not enter the building.

2. Masks: Masks are not required, except under the following condition:

- a. If you are experiencing any COVID or cold like symptoms;
- b. if you have tested positive for COVID within the last 10 days and have already completed the mandatory 5 day absence from The Barn; or
- c. If you have been in close contact with someone who has been confirmed to have COVID within the last five days.
- d. If you need to wear a mask in the building you will need to socially distance yourself when eating or drinking.

* A temperature of greater than 100.4 without the use of fever reducing medications.
