Mission Trip to Chiclayo - Peru



In March, Ivan traveled to Peru with Kerry to explore additional mission opportunities. Their primary objectives were to visit Cajamarca to identify potential locations for future medical clinics and to travel to Chiclayo to support a local family that has been faithfully serving their community and working to establish a new church. During their visit to Chiclayo, the family shared two urgent needs: a dedicated place where the congregation can gather for worship and access to clean, reliable water for the surrounding community. In response, we are working to help secure a rental facility for church services while also raising funds to drill a water well that will provide clean water to local residents.

We are grateful for the opportunity to partner with this community and look forward to seeing how God continues to open doors for ministry and transform lives through these efforts.





In June, Living Faith International Ministries had the privilege of taking a mission team from Grape Creek Baptist Church to Jesús, Peru, to partner in evangelism and community outreach. The team ministered alongside local churches, serving children and encouraging believers as they worked to strengthen existing ministries.
