

## GREEN EARTH BOOK AWARD

## 2026 Submission Guidelines and Eligibility

**The Nature Generation's** mission is to inspire and empower children and young adults to make a difference. We reach our nation's youth through innovative environmental stewardship programs in literature, science, and the arts. **The Green Earth Book Award** promotes books that inspire children to grow a deeper appreciation, respect, and responsibility for their natural environment. Awards are bestowed in six categories:

- Children's Fiction: novels for readers up to age 13
- Children's Non-fiction: books for readers up to age 13
- Young Adult Fiction: novels for readers from age 13 to 21
- Young Adult Non-fiction: books for readers from 13 to 21
- Picture Book Primary: books for readers up to age 5
- Picture Book Intermediate: books for readers age 5 to 8

Picture Books are books in which visual and verbal narratives tell the story - NatGen may move books between Picture Book categories if necessary

## **SUBMISSION SCHEDULE AND INSTRUCTIONS**

The submission period runs from October 1 through December 15, 2025. The long and short lists are announced in March 2026; the winners, honor books, and recommended reading selections are announced on Earth Day, April 22, 2026. To nominate:
