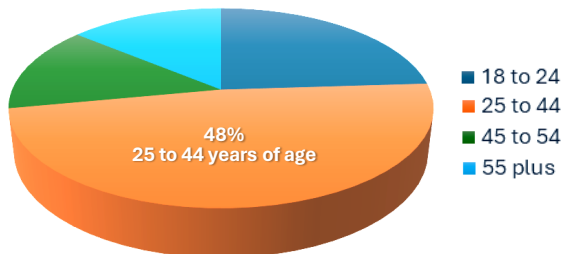

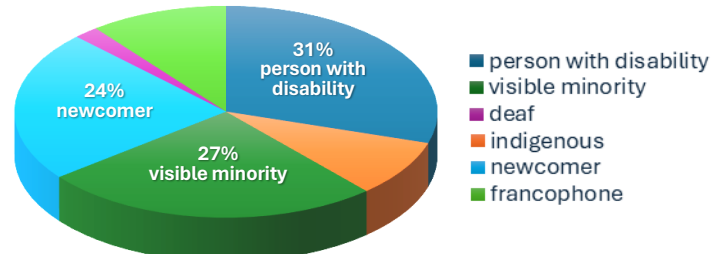

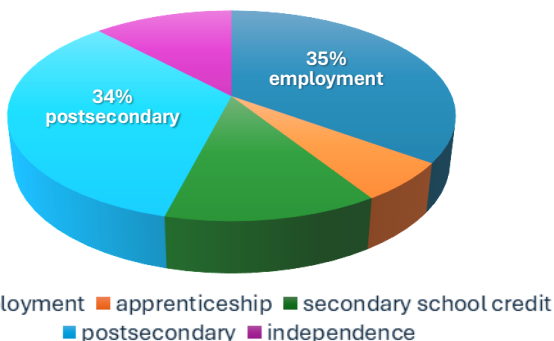
Learner age



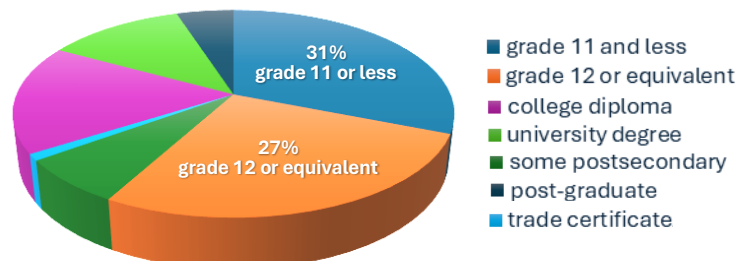
Learners self-identify as
