DAY 1—Sunday, April 25, 2027 | DEPART FROM USA

DAY 2—Monday, April 26, 2027 | ARRIVE IN PARIS, FRANCE

DAY 6—Friday, April 30, 2027

LES ANDELYS-Serenity on the Seine | ROUEN

CLASSIC Take a Guided Walking Tour of Les Andelys—one of France’s most picturesque spots on the Seine.

Later, enjoy a beautiful cruise to Rouen.

ACTIVE Take a Guided Bike Tour to discover and explore the most famous monuments and the lesser known hidden gems of Rouen on two wheels



CLASSIC Take a Guided Walking Tour of Rouen—site of Saint Joan of Arc’s martyrdom—and see the medieval quarter with its 16th-century Astronomical Clock, and Notre-Dame Cathedral.

This evening, enjoy onboard live entertainment.

DAY 7 - Saturday, May 1, 2027 | CAUDEBEC-Ancient Abbeys Along the Seine

CLASSIC Join a Guided Tour to get a taste of authentic tradition in the beautiful region of Normandy. Toast the day with a brandy tasting in Calvados

DAY 9—Monday, May 3, 2027 | VERNON - Monet’s Muses, Castle Courtyards, and Crêpes du Jour

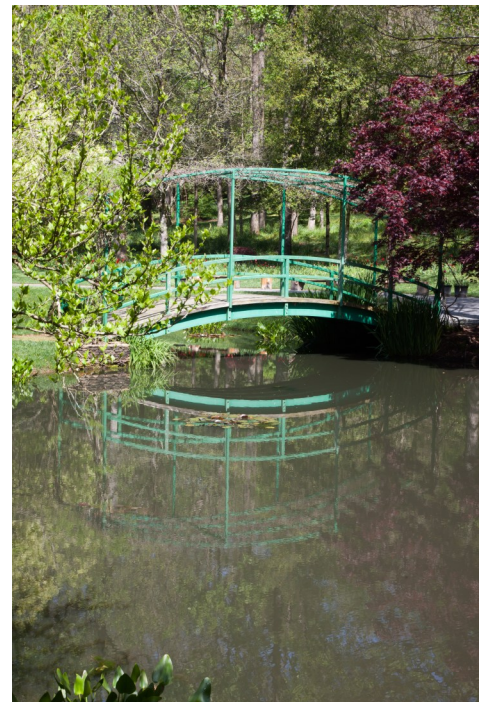
Visit the Adventure Center for today’s activities with your Adventure Host.
