



Versailles Swimming Pool Rates and Schedule for 2021

Season passes for 2021 are available at the Village Administrative Building, 177 North Center Street. Pass forms are also available online at www.versaillesoh.com under the *Municipal/Swimming Pool* section. Please mail the completed form, along with payment, to the address listed on the form, or drop it off at the Administrative Building before 4:30 pm, Friday, May 28th. Beginning Saturday, May 29th forms should be taken to the pool.

General Admission rates will be as follows: Adult - \$4.00; Child 3-17 - \$3.00; and Children 2 & Under are free. Season family pass rates will also remain the same and will be as follows: One Adult (head of household) - \$65.00; One Adult + One Immediate Family Member - \$85.00; One Adult + Two Immediate Family Members - \$95.00; One Adult + Three Immediate Family Members - \$105.00; and One Adult + Four or More Immediate Family Members - \$115.00. All passes purchased **before** Friday, May 7th will be discounted \$10.00.

Please remember, family season passes are limited to immediate family members only, with at least one parent or legal guardian as the pass holder. The Village defines "Immediate Family Member" as a parent or legal guardian and their MINOR or DEPENDENT COLLEGE STUDENT children only. Adult children who live on their own or have their own families must purchase their own individual or family season pass. Also, it is not permissible to have an older sibling as the pass holder on a pass with younger siblings and it is also not permissible to add grandchildren, grandparents, cousins, babysitters, or any other non-immediate family members to a family season pass.

The Versailles Swimming Pool will open for the season on Saturday, May 29th and close on Saturday, August 28th. The pool will be operating on modified hours during opening week and fair week. The Versailles Swimming Pool will also be closed evenings of home swim meets. These hours will be publicized in the Village's monthly Progress Report, local cable Channel 18, website, Facebook page, and The Versailles Policy prior to the modified hours. Hours may be modified due to inclement weather throughout the season. Pool hours for 2021 will be Monday - Friday: 12:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Saturdays: 12:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and Sundays: 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Plan to buy your 2021 family pool pass early at the Village Administrative Building! Visa or MasterCard can be used to pay for season passes at the Village Administrative Building only; however, a 3% convenience fee charge will be added to the total amount due for the pass.

Versailles Poultry Days Plans Full Festival

While several local festivals have been cancelled, the Poultry Days board remains optimistic about this year's festival and is planning a full festival including rides, parades and a social tent. Festival leaders are communicating with the Health Dept and developing a Safety Plan. Poultry Days has received permission from ODOT to close the highway and from the school to use the grounds. All bands have been booked and the contract with the ride company is signed. To help with planning we are sharing the board decision to hold the festival on June 11-13th and not to reschedule. In the event restrictions are placed on the festival we will adjust as needed but will not reschedule. The board will continue to watch health guidance closely.

Applications are being accepted for Miss Chick, Vendors, The Grand Parade and Little Miss Poultry Days contestants. Darke County Solid Waste Management to Host Free Electronics Recycling Month

The Darke County Solid Waste Management District will host a free Electronics Recycling month Saturday, May 1st through Monday, May 31st at 1 Shot Scrap and Recycling, 6377 Hahn Road, Bradford. Items accepted during this event include computers, keyboards, monitors, printers, typewriters, adding machines, calculators, portable TV's (no consoles - limit 5), VCR's and testing equipment, radios, stereo equipment (no consoles), small kitchen appliances, microwaves and toaster ovens, telephonic equipment, telecommunications equipment, and manufacturing equipment. No dehumidifiers or large copiers - tabletop only.

Versailles Income Tax Returns Due May 17th

Income Tax Administrator, Marie Rose, would like to remind all Versailles residents of the following tax filing requirements. **The 2020 Versailles income tax returns and payments are due on Monday, May 17th. Extensions do not extend the time to pay. Village income tax returns cannot be filed electronically. (Ex: online tax filing services, like Turbo Tax, will not file Village tax)**

Mandatory filing is required for anyone 18 or older regardless of income. Retired residents who have registered with the Tax Department are not required to file.

Tax forms are available thru the Village website at www.versaillesoh.com. Tax forms and payments can be mailed to Versailles Tax Department, PO Box 288, Versailles, OH 45380 or dropped off at the Tax Office located at 177 N. Center St. There is also a night deposit box located on the north side of the Administrative Building. Please refrain from folding large clasp envelopes and putting them in the night deposit box, as they will jam and not go through.
