Pet Droppings Reminder

As a reminder to citizens, it is illegal to allow your pet to leave droppings on the sidewalks, in public parks, or on other person's properties. It is up to all citizens to monitor and take responsibility for their pets. We are fortunate to have many sidewalks and parks that encourage walking, jogging, and other outdoor activities, and not only is it a misdemeanor of the third degree carrying a fine of up to \$500, it is extremely offensive and discourteous to other citizens. The Village has provided dog stations for the Village managed parks to provide access to trash bags. Please use them and clean up after your pets in public places.

Fluorescent Bulb Recycling

The Village of Versailles would like to remind citizens that fluorescent bulbs will not be accepted at the Village Offices for recycling. The Village has no way of disposing these types of bulbs. Fluorescent bulbs are accepted at the Darke County Solid Waste Household Hazardous Waste Day in October. Fluorescent bulbs are also accepted at 1 Shot Services just south of Gettysburg. 1 Shot Services phone number is 937-447-3300.

Reminder to Citizens of the Village of Versailles Regarding "Open Burning"

The following rules apply.

(A) No person or property owner shall cause or allow open burning in an unrestricted area except as provided in paragraphs (B) to (D) of this rule or in section 3704.11 of the Revised Code.

(B) Open burning shall be allowed for the following purposes without notification to or permission from the Ohio EPA, except as required in paragraph (B)(3)(f) of this rule:

(1) Heating tar, welding, acetylene torches, highway safety flares, heating for warmth of outdoor workers and strikers, smudge pots, and similar occupational needs.

(2) Bonfires, campfires and outdoor fireplace equipment, whether for cooking food for human consumption, pleasure, religious, ceremonial, warmth, recreational, or similar purposes, if the following conditions are met:

(a) They are fueled with clean seasoned firewood, natural gas or equivalent, or any clean burning fuel with emissions that are equivalent to or lower than those created from the burning of seasoned firewood;

(b) They are not used for waste disposal purposes; and

(c) They shall have a total fuel area of three feet or less in diameter and two feet or less in height except when such fire is used for ceremonial purposes it may have a total fuel area no greater than five feet in diameter and five feet in height, if the ceremonial fire burns no longer than three hours.

The penalty for non-permitted open burning is a minor misdemeanor for a first offense with a fine of up to \$150.00 and subsequent offenses are misdemeanors of the 4th degree carrying a fine of up to \$250 and up to 30 days jail.

Help Needed to Keep Village's Parks Clean and Safe

The Versailles community is blessed to have well-kept parks, the community must work together to keep the parks clean, safe, and enjoyable for all ages. The parks have been prepared for use, and along with increased activity is a request from the Versailles Park Board, Village Administration, and the Police Department to help keep the parks enjoyable for everyone. Should any activity considered detrimental to the park facilities or citizens' general enjoyment be observed, it is requested the activity be reported immediately to the Versailles Police Department by calling 911 or 937-548-2020. (Darke County Dispatch will notify the Versailles Police Department.)

Summer hours for the parks are 5:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. With your help we can continue to be proud of our beautiful well-kept parks that so many people enjoy.
