



Fall Clean-Up Day

On Tuesday, October 12th, the Village of Versailles will conduct the final Clean-up Day of the year. This will be the last clean-up day until next spring for discarding medium to larger items that will not fit within the Village refuse container. Please sit items out at your normal pick up location for pick up on the morning of October 12th. We hope to be able to pick up all items on October 12th, however, if we cannot finish all pickups that day we will pick them up the following day(s) until we are finished.

This Fall Clean-up Day is intended for items that are too large to go into the refuse container, but could previously be set out and picked up **WITHOUT** a large item tag. Normal trash in your Village refuse container will still be picked up on your designated day that week. **This pickup of medium to larger items is in addition to your normal trash pickup!**

Items that previously required a large item tag such as; fence, white goods (appliances; washers, dryers, freezers, refrigerators, etc.), bed springs, furniture, televisions larger than 19" **will still require a large item tag available for \$10.00 at the Village Administrative Office at 177 N. Center Street.** These large item tags may be purchased and items put out for pick up any week, not just for the Clean-up Day on October 12th.

Please note, all freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners, with Freon must have a tag attached verifying all coolant has been removed or the item will not be picked up. Citizens are advised to contact a qualified company or individual to have the coolant removed.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED to be included in any collection include; tires, paint, chemicals, household hazardous waste, CFC's (a class of compounds of carbon, hydrogen, chlorine, and fluorine, typically gases used in refrigerants and aerosol propellants), construction debris, pesticides, insecticides, pharmaceuticals, mercury, fuel. The Darke County Solid Waste District will be holding a Tire Recycling Day on September 22nd (pre-registration required) and a Household Hazardous Waste Day on October 2nd.

As a reminder, 2-yard and 3-yard rental dumpsters are also available for use. Dumpsters are available on a "first come, first serve" basis. Dumpsters are provided for the convenience of disposing of construction/remodeling project waste and additional volumes of general household clean-up waste materials. Rental dumpsters will be provided for a two week period. In order to cover the expenses associated with providing this service, a fee of \$45.00 (2-yard) or \$65.00 (3-yard) will be charged each time the dumpster is dumped during the two week period.

2021-2022 HEAP Applications Available

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is a federally funded program administered by the Ohio Development Services Agency's Office of Community Assistance (OCA). It is designed to help eligible low-income Ohioans meet the high costs of home heating. If you are eligible for assistance, the amount of your one-time HEAP benefit will depend

on federal funding levels, how many people live with you, total household income, and the primary fuel you use to heat your home. In most cases, the one-time benefit will be a credit applied to your energy bill by your utility company (or fuel vendor).

One-Way Traffic Plan to be in Effect for Home Varsity Football Games

The Village of Versailles will again be implementing a one-way traffic plan during home varsity football games to reduce congestion around Hole Field.

There will be one-way traffic to the west along Wood Street from Franklin Street to Grand Avenue; one-way traffic to the east along Ward Street from Grand Avenue to Franklin Street; and one-way traffic to the north along Franklin Street from Ward Street to West Main Street. There will be parallel parking permitted on both Wood and Ward Streets within the one-way traffic zones. Motorists are not to be blocking driveways to properties along these sections of street. Along West Main Street and Grand Avenue, two-way traffic will be maintained, with parallel parking permitted.

For the Wood and Ward Street thoroughfares east of Franklin Street, two-way traffic will be maintained in both directions, with parallel parking permitted.

Motorists are also reminded of the 10 mph speed limit along West Wood Street and West Ward Street that is in effect during home football games. Please use extreme caution in these areas, as pedestrian traffic will be at high levels.
