Easter Vigil is not a normal Vigil Mass, it is 'mother of all Vigils'. It begins outside at the Paschal Fire, has several readings and this year, three adult baptisms and four Confirmations. The time has changed since last weeks bulletin and is now 6:30pm.

Please remember in your prayers: Maggie, Tommy and Richard who will be baptised and Elisabeth who will be Received into Full Communion at the Easter Vigil All four will be Confirmed and receive Our Lord for the first time in Holy Communion, which completes their Christian Initiation.

The Bishop will make his Quinquennial Visitation to the Parish on the 7th April, Divine Mercy weekend. He will also award the Diocesan Medals at the 10am Sunday Mass.

URGENT APPEAL FOR MOUNT ST JOSEPH'S CARE HOME: The Little Sisters of the Poor have had to take the heart breaking decision to close their Leeds Care Home after RAAC concrete was found in 95% of the roof. Over the next few months all 62 residents must be re-homed and over 90 staff face redundancy. The Sisters must meet costs upwards of £500,000 to keep everyone safe until all residents have been found new homes. More details here:
