The following format and content of the price list has been stipulated by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario and is required to be posted by all bereavement licensees.



MINIMUM SERVICES *(IMMEDIATE/DIRECT DISPOSITION)*

The Minimum Services charge represents the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person, whether by cremation or burial.

This minimum service charge is applicable to every family we serve and includes transferring the deceased from the place of death (or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc.) to our holding room, where the deceased will be placed in a casket* of your choosing and securely held until the necessary documentation is completed for burial, cremation, as applicable. Once the required documentation is ready (ex: death has been registered and if applicable, the coroner's certificate for cremation has been obtained), the deceased is transported in a service van to the cemetery, crematorium at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as applicable.

Additional fees may apply for mileage beyond 25 km and Pallbearers for burial only.

- disbursements to be paid to third parties on your behalf, such as the cemetery interment fee, crematorium fee, coroner's fee, death registration fee, etc. (as described on page 9)

ADDITIONAL SERVICE OPTIONS

We offer the following additional services, which are optional:

Additional body preparation services

It is our policy that human remains be identified whenever possible. The identification may be made by anyone who knew the deceased, including a relative, friend, neighbour, co-worker, or clergy person. While identification of a body is possible with the basic required care/preparation, you may wish to consider opting for embalming, as it might afford a more peaceful final viewing experience. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and final disposition. One of our funeral directors will be able to guide you on preparation options and make recommendations based on the condition of the body and the expected service needs.

Visitation

These are informal gathering periods that allow family and friends to come and pay their respects and offer comfort to a grieving family. Suggested visiting hours are 2-4pm and 6-8pm.

Funeral services

This includes services, rites, and ceremonies with the body present in a casket. A funeral service can be religious or non-denominational and can be held in various places, including in our chapel, at a place of worship, a venue such as a club or hall, or at the graveside.

Memorial services or celebrations of life

This is a service to commemorate the deceased, which takes place after the body has been cremated. The cremated remains may or may not be present, as preferred by you; a framed portrait and personal mementos might also serve as a focal point during the memorial service.

Receptions

We offer beautiful facilities in which families may gather and receive guests for a luncheon after the funeral or memorial service. Our reception rooms accommodate up to 80 people.

SERVICE PACKAGE OPTIONS

The service packages below are the ones most selected by our families; however, many other options are available to you. One of our funeral directors can explain your options to you and help you create a unique service that meets your wishes and honours your loved one in a meaningful way.

What is NOT included in the packages below:

- any supplies, such as a casket/cremation container, outer burial container, urn, stationery, etc.
- any additional services beyond those specified in the package.
- additional mileage fees beyond 25 km.
- applicable taxes (HST).
- disbursements to be paid on your behalf, such as the cemetery interment fee, crematorium fee, coroner's fee, death registration fee, etc.

One day of Visitation followed by a Funeral Service/Ceremony next day:

This package includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: four hours of visitation at the funeral home (we suggest 2-4pm and 6-8pm), followed by a funeral service the next day in our chapel, at a church or other venue selected by you; dressing and basic hairdressing services, embalming may be recommended but is not legally required; professional staff supervision and guidance throughout the visitation and service; the use of a visitation suite including equipment to display personal items and floral tributes; the use of our facility on the day of the funeral service, or the assistance and direction of our staff at a church or other venue; flower/equipment vehicle, funeral coach to the cemetery or crematorium, as applicable.

Memorial service in the chapel with Visitation two hours prior to Service/Ceremony:

This package includes all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: a two-hour scheduled period of visitation in our chapel, immediately followed by a memorial service in the same room; professional staff supervision and guidance throughout the visitation and service; the use of our chapel including equipment to display personal items and floral tributes, for the visitation and the memorial service. Cremation takes place prior to the memorial service and the cremated remains may or may not be present, as chosen by you. You may also wish to consider having a private family viewing in advance of the cremation or.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES AND FEES

Any services marked with an asterisk (*) are the minimum services required to carry out a direct burial or cremation. Services such as embalming, visitation, ceremonies and receptions are optional. You may choose only the services you desire.

*** Professional and staff services (for Minimum Services) \$637.00**

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your needs, drafting notices, and advice regarding possible government benefits. Coordination of all activities before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as the cemetery, crematorium, and media outlets (death notices). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance and utilities, accounting and office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance.

OR

Professional and staff services (for visitation and/or services) \$1592.00

Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including but not limited to expert advice on options to meet your needs, drafting notices, and advice regarding possible government benefits. Coordination of all activities, rites, and ceremonies before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as the cemetery, crematorium, florists, and media outlets (death notices). Also included are overhead expenses such as maintenance and utilities, accounting and office administration, insurance and 24-hour access to emergency assistance.

*** Documentation \$330.00**

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, clergy record where required, cremation application or interment permission form. Third-party fees charged for these documents are not included and are itemized below on page 9. We also provide **15** Proof of Death certificates for estate settlement purposes. Proof of Death certificates are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available for purchase from the Office of the Registrar General, or through us as a disbursement.

*** Basic Minimum care of remains \$130.00**

(requires "Facilities for shelter/preparation/embalming")

This service is a minimum requirement. The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the casket/cremation container selected. This also includes bathing, dressing, the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming, basic hairstyling, and cosmetics, if desired. Also includes the removal of a pacemaker or other implants, when required.

Embalming (requires "Facilities for shelter/preparation/embalming") \$480.00

Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. It is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve body tissues between the time of death and visitation/service or disposition of the deceased. ***This service is in addition to those described in "Basic minimum care of remains" above.***

Staff services for Visitation (1 Day) \$312.00

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation for a period up to 5 hours. Includes but is not limited to setting up the room/area (floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia, casket/urn), cleaning and sanitizing, answering phones, greeting, and directing visitors, supervision of parking, provision of lounge services (coffee, tea, light snacks) and processing donations.

Staff services for Visitation 1 to 2 hours prior to service..... \$60.00

This fee is for visitation and service on the same day.

Staff services for Ceremony OR *Celebration of Life*..... \$497.00

At least one licensed funeral director and assistants to coordinate and oversee the ceremony in our chapel or other location, such as: church or auditorium. Includes setting up the room/area (floral arrangements, pictures, memorabilia, casket/urn, cleaning, and sanitizing), greeting and directing visitors, supervision of parking.

The above two charges are from the time the funeral service begins to the final disposition at the cemetery or crematorium and are separate from staff services for visitation, even if the staff present are the same staff that were present for the visitation

Staff services for *Graveside Service*..... \$695.00

At least one funeral director and staff to coordinate and oversee the graveside committal service.

Private Family Viewing (*Immediate Family ONLY*) \$895.00

A private gathering of immediate family to view and identify the deceased. This intimate gathering is limited to immediate family members only for a maximum of 30 minutes. This does not include a ceremony or public visitation. Includes use of the "**Chaise Viewer**" casket by **Northern Casket Co.**, staff, and facilities.

**** If the "*Chaise Viewer*" not selected or utilized ** \$485.00**

FACILITIES

*** Facilities for shelter/preparation/embalming..... \$190.00**

A secure and private room used to prepare, embalm, and/or shelter the body until the time of burial, cremation, or alternative disposition. This charge applies whenever the body is in our facility. *If the deceased is to be held in our facility beyond a period of 7 days, a daily body storage fee of \$50.00 may apply.*

Facilities for Visitation, day prior to ceremony (*requires Staff services for visitation*) \$580.00

Use of designated facilities for visitation for up to 5 hours; day prior to ceremony.

Facilities for Visitation, same day as ceremony (*requires Staff for visitation*) \$261.00

These charges are from the beginning of visitation up to the start of the ceremony, even if the ceremony is in the same room. ***Catering is not included, and details are provided later in this document***

Facilities for Ceremony: (*requires Staff services for ceremony*) \$481.00

Use of designated facilities (funeral home chapel, church, or auditorium) for the funeral service (body/casket is present) or memorial service (urn/cremated remains may or may not be present) for up to 2 hours. This charge is from the time the funeral service begins to the conclusion of the ceremony or final disposition at the cemetery and is separate from Facilities for visitation, even if the visitation was immediately before and in the same room.

TRANSPORTATION

*** Initial transfer of remains \$305.00**

Trained staff and specialized equipment used to transfer remains into our care from the place of death or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc. Additional mileage fees apply beyond 25 km.

*** Service/Administration/equipment vehicles \$355.00**

Specialized van used to transfer remains into our care from the place of death or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport, etc. General duty vehicle used to register the death, pick up cremated remains from the crematorium,

make off-site arrangements, etc. Used for the delivery of floral arrangements, memorabilia, and equipment to the place of visitation, service and/or final disposition as required.

Lead/Clergy vehicle **No Charge**
Used to transport funeral director and/or clergy to location of service and/or place of final disposition.

*** Final transfer of remains**

Vehicle and staff to transfer the deceased to the final place of disposition.

Using a Funeral Coach or service vehicle **\$383.00**

Limousine/Family vehicle **\$395.00**

Limousine and driver to transport family on the day of the funeral, for up to 3 hours and up to 7 passengers.

Artificial grass and mechanical device used to lower casket.

RECEPTION SERVICES:

Facilities for a gathering where food and beverages are to be served. Catering is additional. We offer a variety of menus to choose from. Coffee, tea, dishware, cutlery, and use of the kitchen are included. Serving alcohol requires a Special Occasions Permit obtained from the LCBO and the hiring of a Smart-Server.

Facilities for reception: (requires Staff services for reception) \$1095.00

Use of the reception room for up to 2 hours. Includes set-up and clean-up.

*Use of reception room following memorial/funeral services – includes set-up, use of facilities, staffing, amenities, and clean-up..... **discounted to \$395.00***

*Use of reception room between visitations for a memorial dinner..... **\$145.00***

Staff services for reception: No Charge

One host is provided for up to 30 guests. An additional host is required for every additional 30 guests at no additional charge.

Beer & Wine Service/Smart-Server \$350.00

One Smart-Server is required per every 50 people.

Catering Services.....depending on selection \$14.50 to \$19.00 per person.

Luncheon/dinner reception at either funeral establishment or other place of reception.

Hairdressing \$75.00

While basic hairstyling is included in the Embalming fee, cut and/or colour services are additional.

Professional Pallbearers Fee (Traditional Burial) \$100.00 per Pallbearer

Six pallbearers are required to carry casket to/from Coach to graveside.

*** Removal of pacemakers or other implants..... No Charge**

This procedure is mandatory prior to cremating a body that has a pacemaker or other implant and must be carried out by a licensed funeral director. Includes disposal of device. If a person was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the deceased may not be able to be cremated; please speak with one of our funeral directors for more information.

Sanitary body pouch (recommended for visitation/ceremony if embalming is not desired) \$75.00

The sanitary pouch is recommended for the health and safety of the public and staff when no embalming is chosen.

Professional restorative procedures \$150.00/hour

In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options and their cost. Professional restorative procedures will be charged per hour.

Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains \$350.00

When human remains are to be cremated, payment of a refundable deposit may be required. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground in a cemetery of the funeral home's choosing. If the cremated remains are claimed before they are interred, the deposit will be refunded.

Delayed Arrangement Storage Fee \$75.00 per day

Our services are requested by Executor/Next of Kin/Responsible Person, the deceased is brought into our care, but the final arrangements are unduly delayed by Executor/Next of Kin/Responsible Person. (*Unforeseeable delays are open to consideration*).

Delayed Interment Fee \$350.00 initial fee plus \$125.00 per month

Commonly referred to as a "**Spring Interment**" where a chosen cemetery does not permit winter interments. This fee includes winter storage fees, staffing and funeral coach required for transport of the deceased.

Aftercare Package..... \$420.00
 Assistance with government notifications – CPP/OAS & CRA, Applications – CPP Death Benefit & Survivor's Benefits, Cancellations – SIN, HST/GST, OTB, Driver's Licence, Health & Photo Cards, Passports, Firearms Licence, Estate Fraud Protection (Identity Theft/Fraud). Scattering of cremated remains \$200.00

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the funeral home to third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice. Such items include but are not limited to:

<i>Bereavement Authority of Ontario (B.A.O.) Consumer Protection Fee:</i> The B.A.O. is responsible for protection of the public interest, it regulates, ensures compliance with the laws, conducts inspections, and supports licensed professionals in the funeral industry across the province. The B.A.O. is wholly funded by licensee fees, not tax dollars.	\$30 <i>HST Exempt</i>
<i>Cremation fee:</i> This fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of the body. The fee varies by crematorium.	\$ Varies
<i>Coroner's fee:</i> This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation/alternative disposition or 'Out of Province' shipping to take place.	\$75 <i>HST Exempt</i>
<i>Interment fee:</i> This fee is charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave. The fee varies by cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave. <u>The family is required to make payment directly to the cemetery.</u>	\$ Varies
<i>Municipal death registration fee:</i> This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay.	\$ Varies <i>HST Exempt</i>
<i>Clergy / church / celebrant / musician honourarium(s):</i> This is an amount paid to the clergy, church, celebrant and/or musician for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the third-party, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.	\$ Varies

CASKETS

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Additional options are available upon request. **Unless otherwise noted, all caskets listed are standard adult size.** Oversized caskets are available for additional cost.

Minimum requirements for a casket:

For burial: The least expensive wood casket is suitable and is required by most cemeteries' by-laws for interment, in the interest of the health and safety of the workers involved in the interment process. A metal casket may also be used for burial. A growing number of cemeteries in Ontario offer "green" burials, which may consist of interment of a body without a casket. Since there is no legal definition for a "green" burial, it varies from one cemetery to another. For more information, please speak with one of our funeral directors, or visit www.greenburialcanada.ca.

For cremation: A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak-proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fibre-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation. We offer a selection of caskets below that are suitable for cremation.

****Price includes grave set up: grave dressing and lowering device****

You do not have to purchase a vault, unless the Medical Officer of Health has made the use of vaults and grave liners mandatory in the entire cemetery. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where vaults or grave liners are required; however, the operator must have another area where vaults or grave liners are not required, so that consumers have a choice. A vault or grave liner may be recommended when there are environmental conditions such as poor drainage, or for practical or aesthetic reasons.

The outstanding balance is due within 30 days of signing the contract, beyond which interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR). Prepayment in advance of need:

Insurance: You may purchase a group annuity policy through us, where the proceeds of the group annuity policy will be used to pay for your selected services or supplies at the time they are delivered. Payment may be made by preauthorized debit (void cheque/PAD) or credit card. Time payment plans may be made by preauthorized debit (PAD) or credit card (some limitations and/or restrictions may apply). The policy is held in your name and assigned to our funeral home. Terms and conditions and cancellation policies are set by the Insurance Company.

Guarantee: When paid in full in accordance with the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest / growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest / growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds in excess of the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
