Note from the School Nurse

The ONLY items that can be disbursed to students at school without a Doctor's Order are:

Cough Drops- Must be brought in the ORIGINAL package and kept in the nurse's office.

*The student's name must be written on the package.

*A note from the parent/guardian indicating how often the child may have one,

AND the maximum allowed during the school day is required.

Chap Stick- Must be brought in the ORIGINAL container and kept in the nurse's office.

*The student's name must be written on the container.

*A note from the parent/guardian indicating how often the child may apply it during the school day is required.

Hand Lotion- Cannot be medicated, only hydrating. Must be brought in the ORIGINAL container.

*The student's name must be written on the container

*A note from the parent/guardian indicating how often the child may apply it during the school day is required.

ANY MEDICATION, whether prescription or over the counter MUST be brought in and/or picked up by a parent/guardian. Students may NOT transport any medication without a signed self-carry form.

ALL other over the counter medications must have a Doctor's order and parental consent on file.

This includes, but is not limited to: Acetaminophen (Tylenol), Ibuprofen (Motrin), Neosporin Ointment (Triple Antibiotic), Hydrocortisone Cream, Medication Lotion, Cough/Cold Medication, Orajel, Nasal Spray, Chloraseptic Throat Spray).
