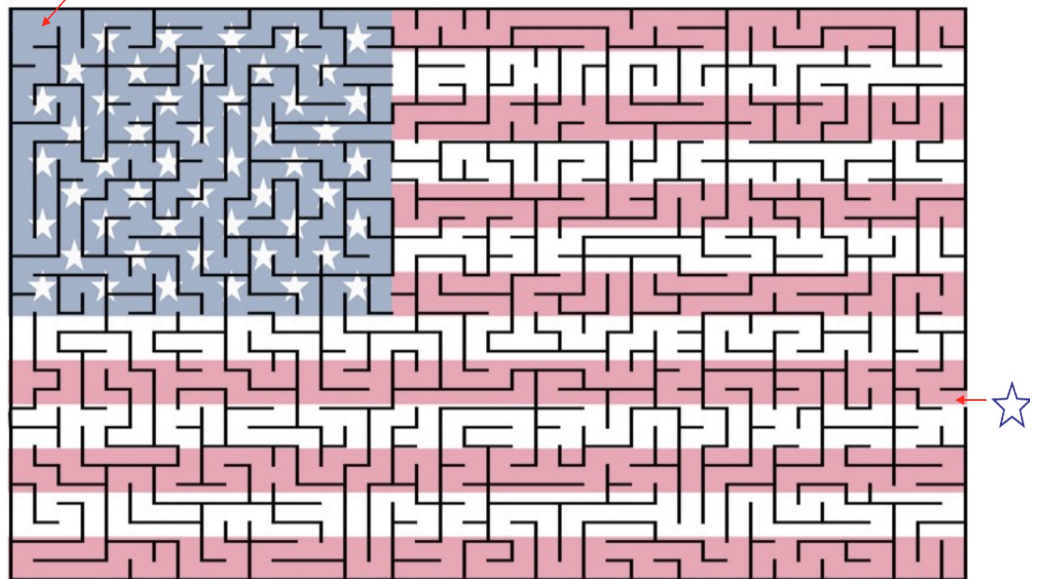

Game Night! UNO!!

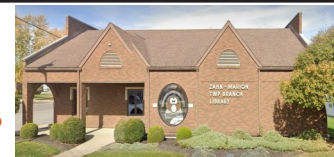
