- 8:35 am Depart west end of Chief's Supermarket Parking Lot, 221 Summit St, Celina, OH - Near the Celina Water Tower
- 8:55 am Pickup and depart St Marys Plaza between Marathon and McDonalds.
- 9:15 am Pickup and depart Bob Evans in Wapakoneta (Park behind building between Bob Evans and the hotel.)
- 11:30 am Arrive at Great American Ball Park. **You can bring your own food and non-alcoholic drinks (small soft side coolers, no glass or cans) into the ballpark. Ball Park vendors only accept credit / debit cards – no cash. No backpacks**
- \$142 - Infield Box Seat in the Shade** and lunch on your own at the ballpark.
- \$191 - Bally Sports Club Seat** - These seats include access to the all-inclusive Bally Sports Club offering a wide selection of food items as well as unlimited water and soft drinks in a climate-controlled setting. Additionally, fans can purchase alcoholic beverages from bars located in the Club. Guests can access the Bally Sports Club by taking the elevators or stairs, near sections 126 and 135, to Club Level.
- 12:40 pm Reds vs Nationals Baseball Game begins.
- 3:45 pm Approximate time to depart the ballpark. We will not be stopping for dinner on your own unless the game lasts longer than anticipated so you may want to bring snacks with you.
- 6:15 pm Approximate time to return to Wapakoneta.
- 6:35 pm Approximate time to return to St Marys.
- 6:55 pm Approximate time to return to Celina.



Cost includes motor coach transportation and reserved seat of your choice for the game.

- **Cancellation Policy - Deposit fully refundable up to 30 days prior to trip departure; 30-14 days prior to departure– 50% of your trip cost is non-refundable; 14 days prior to departure – 100% of trip cost is non-refundable. If replacement is found, you will be refunded all your money except for a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee.**
- Parking will be available in the parking lots at all locations. **Please plan to arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time.**
- The dress for attractions is casual.
- You can bring snacks and drinks on the bus.
