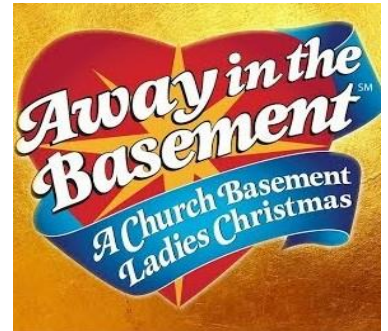

- List of passenger names will be included in final billing
- Cancellation Policy - Deposit fully refundable up to 30 days prior to trip departure; 30-15 days prior to departure– 50% of your trip cost is non-refundable; 14 days prior to departure – 100% of trip cost is non-refundable. If replacement is found, you will be refunded all your money except for a \$25.00 per person cancellation fee.
