Hawaiian Islands Cruise Tour

Day 1 – Depart Late Afternoon for overnight stay at Columbus Hotel - Motorcoach will take you to a Columbus area hotel for an overnight stay prior to your flight to Hawaii tomorrow

Day 2 - Depart for Honolulu – Today, you are transferred by motorcoach to the Columbus Airport for your flight to Honolulu. Your first experience of "Aloha" begins on arrival, where you will be met at your arriving gate with a Traditional Flower Lie. Then you will be escorted to your waiting vehicle for transfer to your Waikiki hotel for a two-night stay. Dinner included at the hotel this evening.

Day 3 – Pearl Harbor and Luau - This morning, begin your Pearl Harbor tour. This of course is focused on the Japanese attack on Dec 7, 1941. The story of what FDR called "The Day of Infamy," is well documented and you will learn about the destruction of the Pacific Fleet and the sinking of the USS Arizona. This day's tour includes a visit to the USS Arizona Memorial, as well as a tour of the Battleship USS Missouri, the Punchbowl Cemetery and other Honolulu Sites. Return to your hotel for a little time to freshen up prior to enjoying an authentic luau dinner at Germains in Honolulu. Immerse yourself in the vibrant culture of the Pacific Islands! Enjoy an aweinspiring Polynesian show by the ocean, under the stars and palm trees. Experience enchanting traditions of ancient Hawaii and embrace the "Aloha spirit" at this backyard-style Hawaiian luau. It's a captivating experience you won't want to miss! Return to the hotel after the show.

Day 4 – Honolulu – Board the Pride of America Cruise Ship
This morning enjoy breakfast at leisure. Enjoy a free morning to relax before meeting your coach and driver for your transfer to the Port of Honolulu to board the Pride of America. As you journey from one exotic island to the next, learn about the Hawaiian culture through the eyes of native ambassadors on board the ship. Island hop Hawaii in style, with a wide variety of restaurants and bars and lounges. This sailing is perfect for whale watching, witnessing Kilauea Volcano or taking in the dramatic landscape and beaches. Come aboard and learn why no one does Hawai'i like Norwegian. Once we board the ship, all land excursions are optional and not included

Day 5 - Kahului, Maui
This morning you arrive on beautiful Maui for a two day stay. Arrival is at 8:00 am and you stay until 6:00 pm tomorrow. Maui is the 2nd Largest of the Hawaiian Islands and it has a surplus of natural splendor with miles of perfect beaches, lush green valleys, volcanic landscapes, plus fascinating history in the whaling town of Lahaina. It's beauty, rich culture and warm hospitality have helped to make it Hawaii's second most popular island. Today is free time to enjoy optional excursions and shipboard activities. Some of Maui's attractions are Haleakala Crater, Road to Hana (many curves –not recommended if you get motion sickness), and Whale Watching.

Day 6 - Kahului, Maui
Enjoy another full day in Maui to just enjoy the island or take in another optional excursion

Day 7 - Hilo, Hawaii - During the night, your ship sailed to Hawaii, the Big Island. Here, we recommend you include the optional Volcanoes National Park Tour where you will feel a sense of awe at Mother Nature's unrivaled power. From the molten magma flowing from Hawaii Volcanoes National Park to the snow-capped heights of Mauna Kea; from the green rainforests of the Hamakua Coast to the jet-black sands of Punaluu Beach; The Island of Hawaii serves as a testament to nature's power.

Day 8 - Kona, Hawaii
Today enjoy free time on the Kona Coast, the west side of Hawaii. You'll have the opportunity to explore Kona Town. You can stroll Ali'i Drive's historical sites, such as Ahu'ena Heiau-which was once King Kamehameha's place of worship, Hulihe'e Palace-used by royalty as a vacation home but now a museum with many ancient Hawaiian artifacts, and Mokuaikaua Church, which is the site of the first Christian church built in Hawaii. You might also want to snorkel amongst a kaleidoscope of tropical marine life. Do some kayaking, or fishing. Land lovers may want to tour a coffee plantation and enjoy some fresh Kona coffee.

Day 9 - Nawiliwili, Kauai
Named after the Wiliwili trees, which once lined its picturesque harbor, this lovely port of Kaua'i is your gateway to what many believe to be Hawaii's most beautiful island. On "The Garden Island," nature is truly the star, from the dramatic mountains and waterfalls to the cool rainforests. Some of Kauai attractions include Waimea Canyon, Wailua River & Fern Grotto, Nepali Coast, the Luau is supposed to be one of the best in Hawaii.

Day 10 - Nawiliwili, Kauai
Enjoy another day in Kauai to explore on your own or take another optional excursion. The ship departs late afternoon

Day 11 - Return To Honolulu, Circle Island Tour
Today you will say good bye to the Pride of America. Upon disembarkation you will be met by another private coach and begin your included Circle Island Tour. The Oahu Circle Island Tour is a guided experience that takes you around the island, showcasing its historical, scenic, and cultural highlights, including famous spots like Diamond Head, Hanauma Bay, and the North Shore beaches. If time allows, the motorcoach will drop the group off at the Ala Moana Center for some last minute shopping and for dinner on your own before returning the group to the Honolulu Airport for your evening flight home

Day 12 – Return to Columbus and return home
Flight arrives at Columbus where a motorcoach will meet you and bring you back to the pickup locations.
