Sabbath Rest

My kids and I are going to camp next week where we will spend the week at Stoney Lake Lutheran Camp, just North of Muskegon. This is my 6th time since being ordained and let me tell you I love "Pastor Camp". Like most camps, youth stay in cabins with their counselors and the counselors and camp staff handle all the programming, meals and activities and supervise the kids. Which means, pastors and youth leaders who accompany our youth get to have a lot of free time on our hands. We get to stay together in a great big house on camp and generally get to hang out together, enjoy participating in activities with our youth, teach a little bit of bible study and help out around the camp when we feel like it. It's a little bit of paradise.

Don't get me wrong, I love taking trips with my husband and children. It is great to help my kids see new parts of the country and experience things we just can't see in Michigan. But as any of you who have traveled with small kids know, those weeks are the most physically and mentally exhausting weeks of the year. Family Vacations, at least at this stage, are nor restful in any sense of the word. But not Pastor Camp. Camp is the one week of the year where I don't have a pile of responsibilities. There are no meals to make or activities to plan. No one's schedule to manage. No emails to return or services to organize. Camp is my one week a year of true sabbath rest.

Are you able to regularly make time for this sort of sabbath rest? Where you set aside your every day responsibilities for an opportunity to rest and rejuvenate. It is important amongst the hustle and bustle of our lives to set aside some time to rest, to reinvigorate our bodies, minds and souls, to listen to God, to break out of the normal rhythms of life to see what emerges. For many it may not need to be a whole week away. And hopefully you can do it more than once a year. A little time with a cup of coffee in the morning, a walk around the block, or a trip to the lake may suffice. But as we will hear in our lessons this week, a little time away from the busyness of our daily tasks to spend time in community with Jesus may be just what the doctor ordered.
