**Treasurer's Report** – Mike: Checking \$223,533, Pull Tab \$21,159, Savings \$28,769; Total account \$273,461.56. Moved \$25K out of Pull Tab account into general fund. Need to look into rules for savings account to see if a non profit can put money into a money market fund, look at Erie Bank? Pulled machine at Burgers 2 Beer as they were no longer interested, Crowleys allowed us to place there making 2 machines total, will need to move.

**North Principal Report** – Victor: discussed the information brought up by Brian Patrick and not allowing district employees to hold executive positions, Victor will make Patrick Ward aware of what this as we need clarity on the issue or a policy # to reference as this will be detrimental to the current and future executive board. Once we receive clarity on the issue and if we need to follow a board policy that doesn't allow for this, we will need to amend the bylaws before the end of the school year. Working with Brian Flick on safety drills, continue to train staff and students on Lockdowns and Alice protocols, there may be a need for some equipment such as first aid kits

**Athletic Director** – Dennis: Winter sports have begun! Girls/Boys basketball, swimming, wrestling, bowling. 14 kids were invited by OHSAA to attend a student leadership club at
