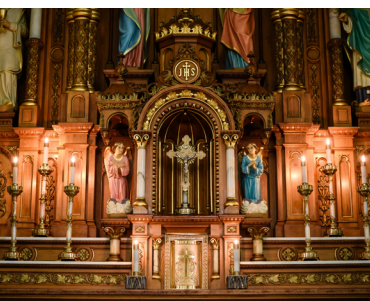

Join us on November 2 at St. Charles Borromeo Church in North Bend, NE, as we celebrate our church's rich history and stunning architecture. A proud nominee for the 2025 National Register of Historic Places, St. Charles Borromeo is renowned for its original elements from the 1916 construction, which beautifully combines Medieval Revival styles with Romanesque and Gothic features.

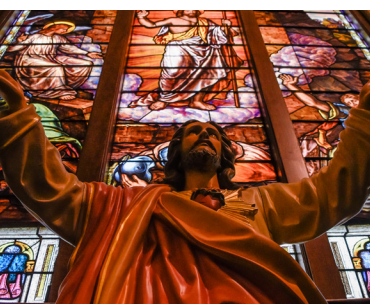


Our event, *Reflections of Glory & Praise* will begin with a short introductory video that provides background information, setting the stage for an exploration of the church's art and culture. Then guided tours of the sanctuary led by local docents will unveil the breathtaking eight stained-glass windows crafted by the renowned Franz Mayer Studio of Munich.



Visitors will also gain insights into ten exquisite pieces of statuary and three dramatic tableaux, including works from the celebrated Daprato Studios of Chicago. Marvel at the artistry of the towering wood altars and the inspirational statuary depicting the fourteen Stations of the Cross.

For those who prefer to privately tour the space, self-guided tour booklets will be available to enhance your exploration. While the event is free to the public, guests are encouraged to make a free-will donation to benefit the North Bend Volunteer Fire Department, Blessing Pantry, and the North Bend Senior Center. Refreshments will be served in the afternoon, and a food truck will be on-site in the late afternoon and evening for food purchases.



As the day draws to a close, join us for an interdenominational *Illumination Service*, where the sanctuary's beautiful windows will be celebrated through narration, scripture, music, and poetry.
