Products applied to the face and body using the hands(palms),primarily leave-on	Class 5
Products applied to the body using the hands (palms), primarily leave-on (Body lotion)	Class 5A
Products applied to the face using the hands (palms), primarily leave-on (Face moisturizer)	Class 5B
Products applied to the hands using the hands (palms), primaritly leave-on (Hand cream)	Class 5C
Products applied to babies using the hands (palms), primarily leave-on (Baby cream, oil, talc)	Class 5D
Products with oral and lip exposure	Class 6
Products applied to the hair with some hand contact	Class 7
Rinse-off products applied to the hair wit some hand contact	Class 7A
