## Financial Commitment for Non WBC Members

The tuition rates of Wilton Baptist Academy are extremely low when compared to the average cost per child in public and private schools - especially in light of the strong academic and spiritual expectations at Wilton Baptist Academy. Tuition income accounts for about 35% of the academy's total operating budget with the remaining balance met through gifts and Wilton Baptist Church's annual budget.

Wilton Baptist Church is aware that for many families it is a real sacrifice to meet the tuition payment each month. The value of a good Christian education cannot be measured by the cost. Although the investment in a quality Christian education is significant, so are the results. May your commitment to that end be met by our God who is able to supply all your needs according to His riches in glory. Claim Philippians 4:19, *"But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus."*

Wilton Baptist Academy primarily admits students whose parents are active members of Wilton Baptist Church who are committed to attending all services and special meetings. Families from churches we have invited are welcome. **Parents must be faithful in tithes and offerings in their Local Church.**

\*Students enrolled by Memorial Day receive 10% off their book fees. Students enrolled after June 15 will have an additional fee of \$25 added to the book fee above.

**Payment Drop-Box** Please leave tuition payment in the metal drop box (near school office) during school hours or church service times or pay online. Please do not put tuition payments in the church offering and tithe box. This will help tithes and offerings remain a thoughtful act of worship.

**Receipts** will be issued each month after the financial staff reviews each account. **The next tuition payment reminder will be issued on the receipt.**

Early Enrollment by Memorial Day receives a \$50 discount per student in the form of a credit to the first tuition payment. The Application Fee of \$150, due by July 7, ensures a reservation for your student. Applications received after July 7 will be \$175.

## Payment Plan

This schedule offers financial flexibility and pace for the Academy families. This plan is designed with your family financial planning in mind. Please note the following payment plan schedule and dates.

- Book & Testing Payment due August 7 (No tuition due – frees cash to buy books & school items.)
- Tuition Payment #1: due September 7.
- Tuition Payment #2: due October 7
- Tuition Payment #3: due November 7
- Tuition Payment #4: due December 7
- Tuition Payment #5: due January 7
- Tuition Payment #6: due February 7
- Tuition Payment #7: due March 7
- Tuition Payment #8: due April 7
- Tuition Payment #9: due May 7
- Tuition Payment #10: due June 7

The last payment of the school year is due **June 7**. Graduates must have all tuition and graduation fees paid by June 7 in order to receive their diploma.

## Testing Fees

Standardized Tests: All students in grades 1-11 are tested **annually** on nationally standardized tests to assess their progress and to determine what, if any, remedial interventions might be necessary to encourage their academic success. The testing fee is \$40 for each student. This fee is due by August 7.

Entrance Exam: All *new* students entering grade 1 and above will be required to pay an entrance exam fee of \$40.00 per student due at the time of testing.

**Additional Expenses and Costs.** Throughout the year additional expenses may include:

Senior High Graduation - \$75 Senior	CPR Class Fee - \$100 (Required for Seniors)
Yearbook – \$25 (at least 1 required per family)	Sports Teams for Jr & Sr High – \$50 (Optional)
Headphone Fee - \$10 (for Grades 1-6)	Student Pictures: Varies based on order (Optional)
Field Trips: Approximately \$50 Per Year	Records Fee (Per Student) - \$10
Kindergarten Graduation - \$15	Uniform Costs range from \$100 to \$250 (Varies)
Transcript Request Fee - \$20	Detention Fee (per detention) - \$40

Each 7-12<sup>th</sup> Grade student will also need his / her own set of quality headphones (wired with a 1/8 jack size). We recommend high quality models that are comfortable for your student. Please purchase a good set at a retailer of your choosing. (*Students in Grades 1-6 will have headphones purchased through WBA. The fee will be added to your account.*)
