

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of \$0.080411 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.080411 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.076768 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.080411 per \$100
DE MINIMIS TAX RATE	\$0.086373 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 from the same properties in both the 2025 tax year and the 2026 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2026, AT 11:00 AM AT THE WILD PEACH COMMUNITY CENTER LOCATED AT 4144 CR 353, BRAZORIA, TX 77422.

BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 SHALL TAKE ACTION ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2026, AT 11:00 AM FOLLOWING THE HEARING TO BE HELD.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Governing Body of BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 this year.
