Notice is hereby given that **BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2** will hold a meeting on **May 4, 2026 at 12:00 p.m.** at the following location in the District: **Wild Peach Community Center, which is located at 4144 CR 353, Brazoria, Texas 77422.**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Roll call and establish a quorum.
2. To receive public comment
3. To approve minutes from prior meetings.
4. To receive and approve the District's financial report and pay District bills.
5. To review and take action regarding the District's 2025 audit.
6. To review, discuss and act on the acquisition of equipment, vehicles or apparatus, to include determination of standard specification and amount of District contribution.
7. To modify, renew or cancel service contracts with the District's service providers.
8. To review, discuss and act regarding amendments to the District's 2026 Budget.
9. To review and approve expenses incurred for the repair, service and maintenance of equipment, vehicles or apparatus.
10. To review and act on improvements, repairs, maintenance and construction of facilities, including but not limited to selection of architectural or engineering services.
11. To receive monthly or quarterly reports from contracted service providers regarding run reports, training, call statistics, department rosters, and emergency services activities.
12. To review and discuss the budgets, financial reports, audit letters and expenditures of the contracted service providers.
13. To review, discuss and act on matters related to Fire Training Field including the purchase of training tools and props and approval of expenses related to upcoming training classes, course materials, equipment and related expenditures to be incurred by the District.
14. To review and act on issues with dispatching.
15. To review, discuss and act regarding the District's contract renewal for bookkeeping services.
16. To designate the Brazoria County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office to prepare the District's No New Revenue Tax Rate and related tax rate calculations for 2026 and to authorize District counsel to publish the necessary 2026 Tax Rate setting notices.
17. To review and take action on the ratification of a continuing Contract with a private law firm pursuant to §6.30 of the Tax Code for the collection of delinquent District ad valorem property taxes and providing for the payment of up to 20% of the delinquent taxes, penalties, and interest which are collected by the attorney under said Contract.
18. To discuss and take action on the imposition of additional penalty on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.07 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same for taxes.

19. To discuss and take action on the imposition of additional penalty on delinquent taxes to defray costs of collection by the District's delinquent tax attorney, pursuant to §33.08 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same.
20. To discuss and take action on the imposition of early additional penalty for collection costs for taxes imposed on personal property on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.11 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same.
21. To review, discuss and take action regarding real estate matters.
22. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
23. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
24. To act upon matters discussed in closed session.
25. To set the date for the June 2026 regular meeting.
