

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE
BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2

Notice is hereby given that **BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2** will hold a meeting on **August 3, 2026 at 12:00 p.m.** at the following location in the District: **Wild Peach Community Center, which is located at 4144 CR 353, Brazoria, Texas 77422.**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Roll call and establish a quorum.
2. To receive public comment
3. To approve minutes from prior meetings.
4. To receive and approve the District's financial report and pay District bills.
5. To review, discuss and propose the District's 2027 Budget.
This is an item to begin the Budget adoption process for the upcoming FY 2027. The District acknowledges the requirement of Government Code §551.043(c)(2) to prepare a taxpayer impact statement when reviewing and adopting budgets. However, certified values are not yet available and the required no new revenue tax rate calculations are not yet available. Therefore, no Taxpayer Impact Statement is included.
6. To review, discuss and propose the District's 2026 Tax Rate.
7. To schedule a public hearing regarding the District's 2026 tax rate and the date of the meeting to adopt.
8. To review and take action on matters relating to an election to be held on November 3, 2026:
 - a. Approve an Order of Election under Texas Tax Code Section 26.07.
 - b. To review and take action to hold an election jointly with other jurisdictions.
 - c. To review and take action to contract with Brazoria County Elections Office for election services.
 - d. To consider and take action on such other Orders, Resolutions and related matters as required or appropriate to call for the District election
9. To review, discuss and act on the acquisition of equipment, vehicles or apparatus, to include determination of standard specification and amount of District contribution.
10. To review, discuss and act regarding amendments to the District's 2026 Budget.
11. To review and approve expenses incurred for the repair, service and maintenance of equipment, vehicles or apparatus.
12. To review and act on improvements, repairs, maintenance and construction of facilities, including but not limited to selection of architectural or engineering services.
13. To receive monthly or quarterly reports from contracted service providers regarding run reports, training, call statistics, department rosters, and emergency services activities.
14. To review and discuss the budgets, financial reports, audit letters and expenditures of the contracted service providers.

15. To review, discuss and act on matters related to Fire Training Field including the purchase of training tools and props and approval of expenses related to upcoming training classes, course materials, equipment and related expenditures to be incurred by the District.
16. To review and act on issues with dispatching.
17. To modify, renew or cancel service contracts with the District's service providers.
18. To review, discuss and take action on Service Agreement with Sweeny Firefighters Association related to the use and maintenance of the training field.
19. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
20. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
21. To act upon matters discussed in closed session.
22. To set the date for upcoming regular and special meetings.
