

Essential Functions:

- Evaluate the patient's needs, including medical, psychosocial, and environmental factors. For managed care cases, may complete initial comprehensive OASIS assessment and opening paperwork if allowed by payer source.
- Develop and implement individualized Plan of Care in collaboration with the physician and patient, addressing physical, medical, psychosocial, and environmental needs. Establish realistic, measurable goals and evaluate patient progress, making adjustments as needed.
- Provide skilled occupational therapy services in the patient's home, including therapeutic exercises, adaptive techniques, and assistive device training.
- Supervise Occupational Therapy Assistants ensuring quality and continuity of care.
- Complete comprehensive OASIS assessments, including Recertification/Follow-Up, Resumption of Care, and Discharge assessments, along with other required documentation, as appropriate for the case and payer source.
- Accurately and timely document all patient treatment, evaluations, progress, and care, and communicate relevant information to other staff members.
- Participate in in-services, quality improvement activities, patient care conferences, workshops, and seminars. Maintain professional competence through continuing education and adherence to certification requirements.
- Educate patients and families on home safety, adaptive equipment, and strategies to maintain or improve function.
- Collaborate with the interdisciplinary team to coordinate care and optimize patient outcomes.
