# Shared Parish Information:

**Office Hours:** Monday through Friday 9AM - 3PM.

**Parishioner Registration:** If you would like to join either of our parishes, please contact the rectory/church office. Registration, the practice of stewardship and regular participation in the sacraments, indicates that a person is an active member of the parish and is eligible to act as a godparent or a sponsor. As a church community seeking to be faith-filled disciples and good stewards, the sacrifice of our time, talent, and treasure is essential for the common good.

**Moving or joining a different parish:** Please remember to notify us if you have a change of address or will be leaving either of our parishes so we can update our records and notify the diocese of the change.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Upon request for the sick or homebound.

**Infant Baptism & Christian Initiation of Adults:** Call the church office, (814)536-0117.

**Marriage:** 9-month notice; pre-marital preparation required.

**Mass Intentions:** ALL mass intentions are handled through the St. John Gualbert office. If you would like to have a mass offered, please fill out the form in the churches or available on the parish website, put it in an envelope with the mass donation (\$10) and drop it off in the collection basket or at the parish office. A copy of the rules and policies for Mass intentions are also available in the churches.

**Do you know anyone who can't make it to mass?** If you have a family member who is sick or infirmed and unable to attend mass, please let us know. Father makes periodic rounds to visit the sick. In time, we would also like to find Eucharistic Ministers to do the same. If there is ever an emergency, call the parish number and leave a message for Fr. Matt. It is very important that those who are seriously ill or in danger of death are able to receive the sacraments, but we don't know unless you tell us. Don't be afraid to call.

**Weekly Contributions:** If you would like your cash gifts to be reflected on your giving statement, please use an offering envelope. Be sure to write your name and the amount given clearly on the offering envelope to insure proper credit. If you attend at another parish, please use your envelopes as they will be returned to us.

**Taking up the Gifts:** If the mass intention is for your family and you would like to take up the gifts at that mass, please let the ushers know about 10 minutes before mass. We have had a few families ask at the last minute and we would rather not ask someone to take up the gifts and then tell them not to because the family of the mass intention has just showed up.

**Daily Mass Missals**—If you would like a copy of “the Word Among Us” daily missal that includes daily mass readings, antiphons, and reflections, please stop or call the St. John parish office. A subscription costs \$20 per person per year.

**Bulletin Deadline:** ALL submissions for the bulletin need to be submitted no later than Tuesday 12:00 PM in order to be listed in the following Sunday edition and must include the name of the submitter. Also, when there are multiple layers to an event, bulletin announcements need to be coordinated through the primary event planner to prevent conflicting submissions.



## **Fr. Canice's Thoughts:**

On the First Sunday of Lent, we are faced with the reality of temptation and the question, "do I truly trust God." The first reading from the book of Genesis, it recounts the temptation and sin of Adam and Eve while the Gospel recounts the temptation of Jesus in the desert. These readings offer several lessons for us to learn:

First, being tempted is not a sin. Jesus was tempted, and Jesus was sinless. Temptation is a normal experience in the spiritual life. Satan tempts us because he wants to take away our peace, but when we trust in God, Satan has no power over us.

Second, when we choose sin we are saying "God, I do not trust you to fulfill all my desires and longings so I will grasp at happiness myself." By instructing Adam and Eve not to eat of the fruit of the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, God was inviting Adam and Eve into a relationship of deeper trust. Sadly they failed to answer that invitation, and as a result, death entered the world. Although this may feel devastating, our Gospel reminds us that there is still hope. In the midst of three temptations, Jesus does not falter but puts His trust in His Heavenly Father. And at the end of the Gospel, Jesus will put His trust in His Heavenly Father in a profound way. At the crucifixion, Jesus not grasp at fruit of an appealing tree in a garden of paradise but will trust in His Father so fully that He will stretch out His hands upon the unappealing Tree of the Cross. And, as St. Paul Reminds us in the second reading, just as death entered into the world through one man's transgression (distrust), new life enters into the world all the more through Man's sacrifice (trust).
