Stewardship Reflection: May 31st- Holy Trinity Sunday

Today we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that the Holy Trinity is the 'central mystery of the Christian faith' (261). The concept of the Triune God – Three Persons in one God – is truly a mystery, almost too lofty for us ordinary people to even begin to grasp. Can the truth of the Holy Trinity teach us anything as everyday Christian stewards? Of course it can!

St John Paul II described the Holy Trinity as a 'Divine Family', a community of Persons Who give themselves completely to each other and Who wishes to share Itself, Its life, with us. These concepts are at the very heart of the stewardship way of life. As stewards, we too are called to share ourselves and our lives with others. As a stewardship parish, we are called to invite others into our community through the gift of hospitality.

Amazingly, the more we give of ourselves to God in love, the more we will find the 'grace of the Lord, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit within us.' The God of the universe – this mysterious, Triune God – invites us to an ever-deepening intimacy with Him when we make our lives a loving gift to Him and to others through the stewardship way of life.

Mass Intentions: ALL mass intentions are handled through the St. John Gualbert office. If you would like to have a mass offered, please fill out the form in the churches or available on the parish website, put it in an envelope with the mass donation (\$10) and drop it off in the collection basket or at the parish office. A copy of the rules and policies for Mass intentions are also available in the churches.

Anointing of the Sick/Homebound: Do you know anyone who can't make it to mass? If you have a family member who is sick or infirmed and unable to attend mass, please let us know. Father makes periodic rounds to visit the sick. In time, we would also like to find Eucharistic Ministers to do the same. If there is ever an emergency, call the parish number and leave a message. It is very important that those who are seriously ill or in danger of death are able to receive the sacraments, but we don't know unless you tell us. Don't be afraid to call.

Weekly Contributions: If you would like your cash gifts to be reflected on your giving statement, please use an offering envelope. Be sure to write your name and the amount given clearly on the offering envelope to insure proper credit. If you attend at another parish, please use your envelopes as they will be returned to us.

Taking up the Gifts: If the mass intention is for your family and you would like to take up the gifts at that mass, please let the ushers know about 10 minutes before mass. We have had a few families ask at the last minute and we would rather not ask someone to take up the gifts and then tell them not to because the family of the mass intention has just showed up.

Daily Mass Missals—If you would like a copy of "the Word Among Us" daily missal that includes daily mass readings, antiphons, and reflections, please stop or call the St. John parish office. A subscription costs \$20 per person per year.

Bulletin Deadline: ALL submissions for the bulletin need to be submitted no later than Tuesday 12:00 PM in order to be listed in the following Sunday edition and must include the name of the submitter.

Quote of the Week:

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is an immense mystery, which exceeds the capacities of our minds, but that speaks to our heart, because we find it encompassed in that expression of Saint John which summarizes all of Revelation: "God is love" -Pope Francis (May 31,2021)

Fr. Canice's Thoughts:

Today we celebrate and ponder the Mystery of Mysteries! That is, the eternal mystery of One God who is Three Eternal and Divine Persons. Simply put, we are pondering and entering into the Mystery of Who God is - He is Love (1 John 4:8). This Mystery contains the entire meaning and purpose of our lives. If God is Love, and we are made in His Image and Likeness, then we are made in the image and likeness of Love. Love is the entire meaning, purpose, and destiny of our life.

Allow me to share a reflection from my favorite theologian, Christopher West, who eloquently articulates the mystery of Who God is as well as the profound impact this has on our entire existence:

To recognize God as Trinity is to recognize God as perfect, blissful "love-as-communion." And that means a love eternally poured out by the One who is love's originator, eternally received by the Beloved and eternally returned to the One who originally poured it out. And then eternally poured out again and again. The one who "pours out" is the Father, the one who "receives" is the Son, and the eternal "procession" of love between them is the Holy Spirit. Recall that our bodies tell this story: the life-giving communion of husband and wife is "a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit" (CCC 2205). This is what makes our bodies not only biological but also theological. St. Paul, pray for us that we might embrace this "grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit." Pray for us that we might keep this grace close to our hearts and live out the theology of our bodies.
