Mass Intentions: ALL mass intentions are handled through the St. John Gualbert office. If you would like to have a mass offered, please fill out the form in the churches or available on the parish website, put it in an envelope with the mass donation (\$10) and drop it off in the collection basket or at the parish office. A copy of the rules and policies for Mass intentions are also available in the churches.

Anointing of the Sick/Homebound: Do you know anyone who can't make it to mass? If you have a family member who is sick or infirmed and unable to attend mass, please let us know. Father makes periodic rounds to visit the sick. In time, we would also like to find Eucharistic Ministers to do the same. If there is ever an emergency, call the parish number and leave a message. It is very important that those who are seriously ill or in danger of death are able to receive the sacraments, but we don't know unless you tell us. Don't be afraid to call.

Weekly Contributions: If you would like your cash gifts to be reflected on your giving statement, please use an offering envelope. Be sure to write your name and the amount given clearly on the offering envelope to insure proper credit. If you attend at another parish, please use your envelopes as they will be returned to us.

Taking up the Gifts: If the mass intention is for your family and you would like to take up the gifts at that mass, please let the ushers know about 10 minutes before mass. We have had a few families ask at the last minute and we would rather not ask someone to take up the gifts and then tell them not to because the family of the mass intention has just showed up.

Daily Mass Missals—If you would like a copy of "the Word Among Us" daily missal that includes daily mass readings, antiphons, and reflections, please stop or call the St. John parish office. A subscription costs \$20 per person per year.

Bulletin Deadline: ALL submissions for the bulletin need to be submitted no later than Tuesday 12:00 PM in order to be listed in the following Sunday edition and must include the name of the submitter.

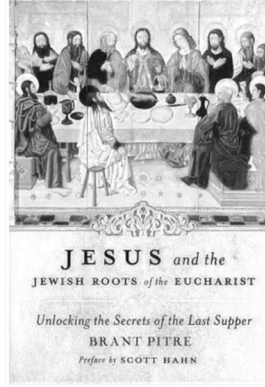

Fr. Canice's Thoughts:

On this glorious solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, we profess our faith in Jesus' True Presence. In the Eucharist! In today's gospel, we hear Jesus say "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you." In Peter Kreeft's outstanding reflections on today's Mass readings, he beautifully explains this passage:

There are two Greek words for "life." One, bios, means natural, mortal life. The other, zoe, means supernatural, eternal life. That's the word Christ uses here. When we receive Christ in the Eucharist, our bios changes into zoe, just as in the Eucharist the bread and wine miraculously change into Christ's Body and Blood. It is as miraculous as a frog changing into a prince in the fairy tales. It is like Pinocchio changing from a wooden puppet to a living boy. At the very heart and essence of Christianity is this astonishing miracle.

It's not just a symbol. The great Catholic novelist Flannery O'Connor was once at a fashionable dinner party in New York City, and the fashionable people were saying fashionable things, and one of them said something like this: "Flannery, I admire some things about your Catholic faith. For instance, the Eucharist: 'This is my Body' That's a beautiful symbol. But of course you don't take that literally?" Flannery shocked them with her reply: "Well, if it's a symbol, to hell with it." In his discourse about the Eucharist, Jesus made sure we would not interpret his language only symbolically when he prefaced his shocking remarks with "Amen, amen, I say to you," which is a rabbinic formula for "Don't take this merely symbolically; take it literally, in the strongest possible sense." The Eucharist is not merely a symbol; the ordinary bread that we eat is a mere symbol of the Eucharist. That's what Jesus means when he says, "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink."

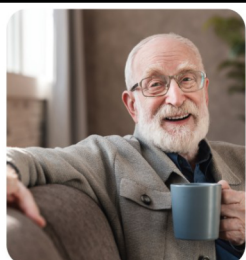
