Parishioner Registration: We always welcome new parishioners. It is important for us to keep accurate records when time comes for sacraments, certification as a Baptismal/Confirmation Sponsor, as well as charitable giving notices. If you would like to register or have moved, please fill out a registration form at the entrance and drop it in the collection.

Moving or joining a different parish: Please remember to notify us if you have a change of address or will be leaving either of our parishes so we can update our records and notify the diocese of the change.

Mass Intentions: ALL mass intentions are handled through the St. John Gualbert office. If you would like to have a mass offered, please fill out the form in the churches or available on the parish website, put it in an envelope with the mass donation (\$10) and drop it off in the collection basket or at the parish office. A copy of the rules and policies for Mass intentions are also available in the churches.

Anointing of the Sick/Homebound: Do you know anyone who can't make it to mass? If you have a family member who is sick or infirmed and unable to attend mass, please let us know. Father makes periodic rounds to visit the sick. In time, we would also like to find Eucharistic Ministers to do the same. If there is ever an emergency, call the parish number and leave a message. It is very important that those who are seriously ill or in danger of death are able to receive the sacraments, but we don't know unless you tell us. Don't be afraid to call.

Weekly Contributions: If you would like your cash gifts to be reflected on your giving statement, please use an offering envelope. Be sure to write your name and the amount given clearly on the offering envelope to insure proper credit. If you attend at another parish, please use your envelopes as they will be returned to us.

Taking up the Gifts: If the mass intention is for your family and you would like to take up the gifts at that mass, please let the ushers know about 10 minutes before mass. We have had a few families ask at the last minute and we would rather not ask someone to take up the gifts and then tell them not to because the family of the mass intention has just showed up.

Daily Mass Missals—If you would like a copy of "the Word Among Us" daily missal that includes daily mass readings, antiphons, and reflections, please stop or call the St. John parish office. A subscription costs \$20 per person per year.

Bulletin Deadline: ALL submissions for the bulletin need to be submitted no later than Tuesday 12:00 PM in order to be listed in the following Sunday edition and must include the name of the submitter.

Deacon Rick's Corner:

3 Lessons from Today's Gospel

God's Grace Isn't Earned, It's Given



In the eyes of God, salvation is a gift, not a wage. The same eternal reward is offered to all, whether we arrive early or late to His vineyard. Let us rejoice in His mercy, not measure it.

Comparison is the Thief of Gratitude



The workers were content until they compared. In life, comparison robs us of peace and blinds us to our blessings. Today, let's look to God, not others, and be grateful for what we have.

It's Never Too Late to Return to God



The latecomers were still chosen. With God, it's never too late. Every moment is a chance to respond to His call. Don't dwell on when you started, just say yes today.

Fr. Canice's Thoughts:

Allow me to share an interesting reflection from Dr. Peter Kreeft on today's Gospel reading.

God always surprises us. Not by his justice but by his mercy. Sometimes his mercy even scandalizes us, as in today's Gospel. The master's generosity overpaid the workers who worked only for an hour, without underpaying the others, but those others were resentful and envious. We sympathize with their protest. We all tend to be envious of those who had it easier than we did, who were born into families or nations that were richer or more comfortable or happier than ours. It seems that either God is not fair at all, or, at least for him, fairness has to take second place to generosity. We should be distrustful of that instinctive reaction of ours. We value equality, but we need to be sure that our passion for equality is not a disguise for envy. Envy is the stupidest of all sins, because it never gives you one second of joy, even fake joy. Generosity is more important than equality, because generosity is part of love and equality is only part of justice, and love is more important than justice. One of the things Mother Teresa loved to say the most was that "God cannot be outdone in generosity." That is one of the ways in which his ways and thoughts are as high above ours as the heavens are above the earth: so high that it shocks us.
