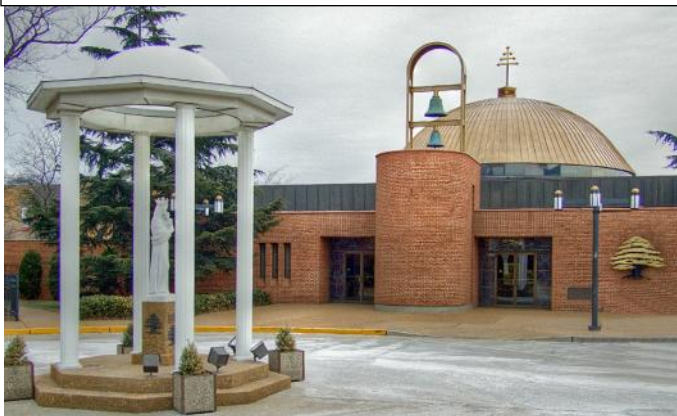

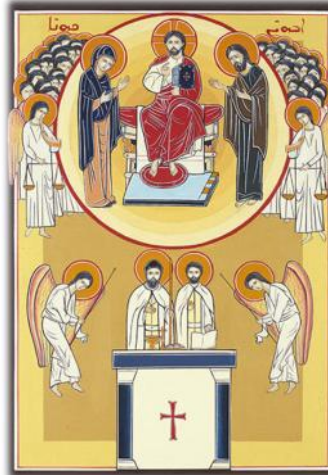

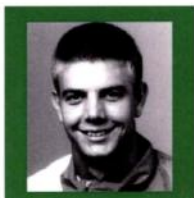

**St. Maron 350-410 AD
Feast Day, Feb. 9
Priest and Hermit
Patron and Father of
the Maronite Church**

Saint Maron was a mystic who started this new ascetic-spiritual life that attracted many people in Syria and Lebanon to become his disciples. Accompanying his deeply spiritual and ascetic life, he was a zealous missionary with a passion to spread the message of Christ by preaching it to all he met. He sought not only to cure the physical ailments that people suffered, but had a great quest for nurturing and healing the "lost souls" of both non-Christians and Christians of his time. This missionary work came to fruition when in the mountains of Syria, Saint Maron was able to convert a temple into a Christian church in Kalf Nabu. This was to be the beginning of the conversion to Christianity in Syria which would then influence and spread to Lebanon. After his death in the year 410 in Kalota, his spirit and teachings lived on through his disciples. The Maronite movement reached Lebanon when Saint Maron's first disciple, Abraham of Cyrhus, who was called the Apostle of Lebanon, realized that there were many non-Christians in Lebanon and so he set out to convert them to Christianity by introducing them to the way of Saint Maron. Maronites have always remained in full communion with the Holy See / Chair of St. Peter.
