



# A note from the pastor



## Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon of Los Angeles

March 18, 2026

Dear Monsignors and Fathers,

Greetings and Peace!

It is with great pastoral concern for the ongoing crisis in southern Lebanon that I write to you today. Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of our Christian brothers and sisters and other innocent victims of violence in Lebanon and the region who are struggling to survive and live with dignity in dire conditions.

The Church in Lebanon is already there providing vital emergency humanitarian relief and medical and psychological care for the sick and suffering. Given the extraordinary nature of this crisis, I am asking you to take up a special collection to provide humanitarian relief and pastoral support for our affected brothers and sisters, especially in the villages of south Lebanon. This special collection is to take place on Palm Sunday. Please notify your parishioners ahead of time so that they are prepared to make their donations.

The situation in southern Lebanon cries out for our assistance and I am asking each of our parishes to do their part. Once the collection is taken, please notify the Chancery so that we can withdraw the funds from your accounts and distribute them accordingly.
