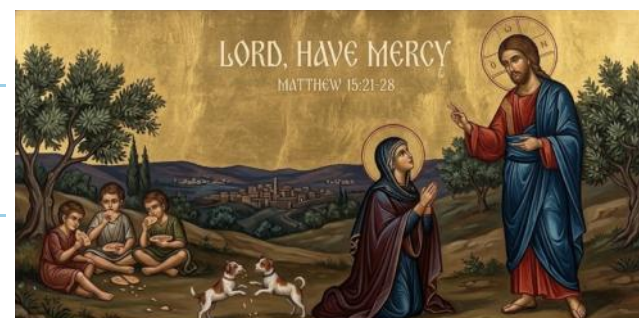

# A note from the pastor

## Saints /Blesseds from Lebanon and the surrounding region

Lebanon has a rich modern history of canonizations and beatifications. The Catholic Church has formally recognized several prominent Lebanese saints and blesseds through recent decades for their heroic virtues, profound mysticism, and witness during times of persecution.

**Saint Charbel Makhlof** (1828–1898): A legendary Maronite monk and hermit from Bekaa Kфра; beatified in 1965 and canonized in 1977 by Pope Paul VI.

**Saint Rafqa Petra Ar-Rayess** (1832–1914): A Maronite nun who endured blindness and extreme pain with joy; beatified in 1985 and canonized in 2001 by Pope John Paul II.

**Saint Nimatullah Youssef Kassab Al-Hardini** (1808–1858): A teacher, scholar, and mentor to Saint Charbel; beatified in 1998 and canonized in 2004 by Pope John Paul II.

**Blessed Estephan El Douaihy** (1630–1704): Maronite Patriarch and historian; beatified in August 2024 under Pope Francis.

**Blessed Leonard Melki** (1881–1915): A Capuchin priest and martyr; beatified in May 2022.

**Blessed Thomas Saleh** (1879–1917): A Capuchin priest and martyr; beatified in May 2022 alongside Father Melki.

**Blessed Elias Boutros Hoayek** (1843–1931): Maronite Patriarch; beatified in July 2006 by Pope Benedict XVI.

**Blessed Estephan Nehme** (1889–1938): A Maronite Lebanese monk; beatified in June 2010.

**Blessed Yacoub Alkbouche** (1875–1954): Franciscan priest and founder; beatified in June 2008.

**Blessed Béchara Abou-Mourad** (1853–1930): Greek-Melkite Basilian priest; beatification authorized by the Vatican in 2026.

**The Massabki Brothers** (d. 1860): Francis, Abdel Mooti, and Raphael Massabki, Maronite lay martyrs of Damascus, canonized/beatified collectively as part of the Damascus martyrs.

**Blessed Ignatius Maloyan** (1869–1915): Armenian Catholic Archbishop born in Mardin

**Saint Maron** (5th Century): The spiritual father of the Maronite community, whose ancient legacy remains foundational (historic baseline honored across centuries).

**Saint John Maron** (7th Century): First Maronite Patriarch, historically revered with deep historical ties to Lebanese monastic institutes.

**Saint Marina the Monk** (5th Century): Highly revered legendary ascetic saint of the Qadisha valley tradition.
