

#### All Saints' Day

In the early 7th century Pope Boniface IV consecrated the Pantheon in Rome, formerly a temple to all the gods, as a church dedicated to Saint Mary and the Martyrs, and ordered that that date, 13th May, should be celebrated every year. It became All Saints' Day, a day to honor all the saints, and later, at the behest of Pope Urban IV (d. 1264), a day specially to honor those saints who didn't have a festival day of their own. In the 8th century, on 1st November, Pope Gregory III dedicated a chapel to all the saints in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Gregory IV then made the festival universal throughout the Church, and 1st November has subsequently become All Saints' Day for the western Church.



The Orthodox Church celebrates All Saints' Day on the first Sunday after Passover - a date closer to the original 13th May.

The Maronite Eastern Catholic Church celebrates the week of the Commemoration of the Righteous and Just (Saints), two weeks before Great Lent.

All Souls' Day is commemorated too in the Maronite tradition one week before the Great season of Lent begins.

#### Sun. Nov. 2, 2025 - beginning of the Maronite Liturgical Year

The Maronite Church's liturgical calendar and lectionary follows that of the Syro-Antiochene Christian tradition and is based on the stages of the life of Our Lord Jesus Christ: his birth, public ministry, passion, death, resurrection, and looks forward to his return in glory.

The Maronite liturgical calendar consists of six season and begins with the Sunday of the Consecration of the Church on the 1st Sunday of November and ends with the Season of the Holy Cross, last Sunday of October in accordance with the Syro-Antiochene tradition.
