Our professional fee includes the following...

- We are available 24-hours a day, 7-days a week and can advise you accordingly by telephone, e-mail or home/hospice arrangement if required. We will carry out all administration, contact third parties such as Doctors, Clergy, Crematoriums and Cemeteries and in some cases H.M Coroner.
- We will bring your loved one into our care, within a 30-mile radius of IP33 and during normal weekday working hours.
- We will provide a black motor hearse on the day of the funeral from our funeral home to the place of service. (Horse-drawn and other hearse alternatives are available at extra cost. Please ask for further details).
- Provision of pallbearers and attendants on the day of the service. (If more than six pallbearers are required, there will be an extra charge)
- The Funeral Director and Conductor on the day of the service, to liaise with family, mourners and Clergy and provide assistance thereafter.
- Washing and dressing of your loved one in their own clothing (or we can provide a gown). This can be carried out by either male or female staff. Appropriate hygienic treatment, such as embalming, is available at an additional cost which can be discussed.
- Providing the appropriate mortuary facilities to care for your loved one until the day of the funeral.
- Your loved one will always remain in our care until the day of the funeral.
- Viewing at our Chapel of Rest is available at any time, by appointment, including weekends.
- Provision of a fully fitted and lined high-quality Oak veneered coffin suitable for both cremation or burial. (We have an extensive range of coffins and caskets available at an additional cost. Please ask for further details and to see our brochures.)
- Choice of dates and times for the funeral service.
- Administration of any charitable donations received in memory of your loved one, setting up of a memorial page online, organising Order of Service and arranging floral tributes.

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Our professional fee does not include any third-party fees (also known as disbursements)

Third-party disbursements, what are they?

Third-party fees are costs that are necessary for a funeral to take place, but are not included in the services of a Funeral Director unless otherwise stated. They are the costs paid for services out of the Funeral Director's control, payable to a third-party, by us on your behalf. Examples of these are:

Cremation fees: This is the cost of the cremation itself - it also includes the use of the Chapel at the Crematorium for a 40-minute service (approx time). Prices range from £895 to £1,425 at the West Suffolk Crematorium depending on the time of day. Other crematoriums are available, please discuss this with your Arranger.

Burial fees: These will vary from place to place (we can find this out for you). Fees may include:

- The purchase of the grave plot
- Grave reopening if the plot is an existing grave
- Interment fee
- New grave fee
- Removal of existing headstone

Minister/Officiant fee: A fee payable to the Minister or Officiant taking the funeral service which is from £200.

Local Direct Cremation

We can now do what is known as a "Direct Cremation" at West Suffolk Crematorium, and visits to our Chapel of Rest are included with this option. Our service is still professional and dignified, however a restricted option and will not allow for any mourners to be at the service. Again, we include our professional fees plus that of the Crematorium.

Please ask us for more details about this service.

*An out-of-hours into care fee is added should the death occur at a private residence or care home outside of the hours of 9am-6pm Monday to Friday and on a Bank Holiday when our services are required. 100% of the cost will be requested at the time of instruction.

The fee for this starts from £1,350 (Inclusive)

We understand that funeral costs are constantly increasing throughout the UK. It is therefore our aim to keep these costs as low as we can. In order to do this and not have outstanding debts, we do require the funeral invoice to be paid 48-hours before the service in cleared funds. This way we aren't increasing our next family's fees due to someone else's debt. 50% of the cost will be requested at the time of arranging the funeral.
