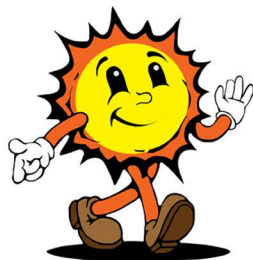


THE FUN DAY IS BACK!

YOUR NEW LOOK VILLAGE HALL

We were successful in securing grants from Hull CVS and Hull City Council to partly refurbish our kitchen that had been installed when the Village Hall was opened 30 years ago, so was well overdue a refresh.

The improvements that we were able to make were: Brand new worktops and base cupboards in a sleek black and grey colour scheme, new white goods including an energy efficient electric range cooker and hob, new grey flooring throughout the kitchen & new kitchen sink facilities

We will finish off the refurbishment by decorating, including the wall units. The Association has funded the project by approximately £3000 from its own funds.

Thanks to our grant funders for making our kitchen more pleasant. The kitchen is free to use when you hire a room at the Village Hall, with an additional cost of £15 if you wish to include use of the cooker/hob.



BIG PARTY BOOKINGS

When booking your event, if it is a large party of more than 100 people, you will be required to pay a **£50** refundable deposit in addition to your hire fee, used to cover any damages incurred or for late exit after your event.

Any event that includes a time period after **8pm** will attract an increased hire fee of **£18 per hour for Victoria Dock residents** or **£33 per hour for non-Victoria Dock residents** for the duration of the time period booked following **8pm**.
