Summer Camp at Wakeman Boys & Girls Club

Each clubhouse offers a full range of Day Camps, with some specialty camps at SPT and SBC. Our clubhouses provide a safe, welcoming space for members to make friends, learn, and have fun! Indoors, the air conditioned facilities host one or two gymnasiums, a game room, dedicated teen space, and multi-purpose classrooms for programs focused on art, STEM and leadership development. Outdoors, members can enjoy Gaga Ball and grass play areas. SPT and MAC have an outdoor Sports Court. SPT has an outdoor stage and archery range. Archery is for 3rd grade and older.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP

Membership is available to all students in grades K-12 regardless of their age or town of residence.

- Enrollment is based on the grade youth attended in spring 2024. Verification of 2023-24 school enrollment for kindergartners is required.
- A current membership is required to participate in any program, Open-Gym Drop-In, or Summer Camp Session. Any full membership purchased August 2023 or later may be valid for Summer Camp 2024.
- A reduced Summer Only Membership is also available for purchase.
- Membership is valid for one year (365 days) from purchase.
- Membership is valid at Southport Clubhouse, Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse, and Madison Avenue Community Clubhouse.

Summer Opportunities for Teen Members

SUMMER LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS

Our CIT and LIT programs help teens develop and strengthen skills as camp counselors and future leaders in all walks of life. Both distinct programs work directly with camp groups while also learning behind-the-scenes camp planning and organization.

LEADER-IN-TRAINING (LIT) PROGRAM (TEENS COMPLETING GRADE 8)*

This program is designed as an introduction to community service in a role that allows the teens to grow personally, learn leadership and job readiness skills, and practice teamwork. Teens work with counselors and directors to plan, design, and implement science, art, or fitness activities for their groups. LITs attend leadership training and online child safety training through Boys & Girls Clubs of America and have an opportunity to become First Aid certified. Enrollment is limited.

**LIT program is offered at the Southport Clubhouse only.*

COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING (CIT) (TEENS COMPLETING GRADES 9, 10, 11)

This program is designed to help prepare teens to become camp counselors or junior staff, build leadership skills, develop job readiness skills, and explore careers. Teens apply leadership skills from the program by assisting summer camp groups and by planning and implementing activities. CITs attend leadership training and online child safety training through Boys & Girls Clubs of America with an opportunity to become First Aid certified. CITs receive a weekly evaluation from their supervisor and camp staff. These evaluations help assess each CIT's skills and further development of job skills.

The CIT program is available at Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse, Southport Clubhouse, and Madison Avenue Community Clubhouse.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Application is available on the Summer Camp web page beginning February 13.
2. Complete a CIT or LIT application form and schedule an interview.
3. CIT Program participants must commit to 2 weeks of volunteering for full days of camp, with camp hours of 8:45am-3:45pm. CITs may apply for as many additional weeks as they wish.

IF ACCEPTED TO THE CIT OR LIT PROGRAM, CANDIDATES WILL:

- Attend a 3-hour CIT/LIT training in June prior to camp. Date options will be available by May 17.
- Complete additional 60-90 minute online child safety training prior to camp.
- Submit Camp Medical Form, listing medical examination within the past 3 years.
- Undergo criminal background check and reference checks by Wakeman Boys & Girls Club.
- Be enrolled as a Wakeman Boys & Girls Club member for summer 2024.

10 WEEKS OF CAMP OFFERED

9 sessions of Full Day Camp are available for members finishing grades K-8 in June 2024. Half day football and basketball camps are available in week 1 at the Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse. An additional late August week of field trips is available for 4th-8th graders at the Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse. Other specialty sessions and Day Camp options are available at our Southport Clubhouse. Specialty camp grades vary; check listing.

GRADE ELIGIBILITY: To register, campers must be enrolled in grades K-8 during the 2023-24 school year.

DAILY SCHEDULE: Full Day Camp hours are 9:00am-3:30pm. Campers may be dropped off starting at 7:45am for an additional fee. After Care is available for an additional fee. See below. Each week is filled with indoor and outdoor sports, computers, game room and studio time, arts & crafts, academic enrichment, group games, guest speakers, and special one day events!

MEALS: We provide FREE lunch through the City of Bridgeport School Nutrition Center. Campers are also welcome to bring their own lunch in a brown paper bag with their name labeled on it.

New this year! "Take Out Thursdays" offer an optional delicious lunch from a different local restaurant each week. Additional fee will be collected.

WEEKLY THEMES: Each week has a special theme, so the activities and games are fresh and exciting for campers. Some past themes have been Lego Week, STEAM week, and the annual favorite Color Wars Week.

COUNSELOR IN-TRAINING (CIT) PROGRAM: Building on the tradition of developing strong young leaders, our CIT program for members finishing 9th-11th grade offers an enriching volunteer opportunity to build leadership skills and positively impact our younger campers.

FOOTBALL CAMP

GRADES: 5-8

FEE: \$175*

SESSION DATE: JUNE 17-21

HALF DAY: 8:30AM-12:30PM

Whether your athlete is an experienced player or just starting football, this program will be an experience they won't forget. Our goal is to teach our athletes the correct techniques and practice habits that will allow them to reach their full potential. Your athlete will receive the best training available from an experienced and veteran staff of coaches. Players are taught teamwork, consideration of others, self-discipline, and how to attain their potential in sports and life. Athletes will also learn the importance of achieving good grades and selecting the correct role models.

Camp is held at the Cal Ripken Field, which is located next to Geraldine Claytor Magnet Academy at 141 Ocean Terrace, Bridgeport. Campers will meet at the Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse and make the short walk to the field with staff each day. Each day, campers are provided a variety of deliciously healthy snacks to fuel their adventures.

Camp is focused on individual enjoyment of fitness activity, self-motivation, and friendly competition. This is a fun and supportive environment for all boys and girls, regardless of fitness level. This year, bikes will be required no more than one day of camp.

Some adventures will change in the second session of Be Fit Camp. The weekly schedule of adventures is finalized in late spring. Campers receive a welcome email with the week's schedule, waivers, and key details two weeks before camp begins. All campers receive a dri-fit camp shirt.



Other Information to Know



HEALTH AND INSURANCE FORMS

Health, Insurance, and Permission to Treat forms are due within 48 hours of registration. According to CT State Law, your child cannot participate in camp without these forms on file at the Club. A physical exam dating back 36 months from the camper's final day attending 2024 summer camp is acceptable. We do not keep physicals on site from the previous year.

If camper is bringing medication to camp, an Authorization for Medication Administration from a physician and written parent/guardian permission are required. Medications must be in the original package with the correct pharmacy label and a photo of the camper. Drop off medications to the Club during the week prior to camp.



WAITING LIST | SPECIAL PLACEMENT

FORMULARIOS DE SEGURO MÉDICO

LISTA DE ESPERA | COLOCACIÓN ESPECIAL

If all paperwork is not submitted before Thursday, June 13, the camper will not be able to start camp.

Si no se entrega toda la documentación antes del jueves 13 de junio, el campista no podrá comenzar el campamento.





MEDICINE

Any child with medication needs and/or allergies must provide the camp a signed release from their physician 7 days prior to start of camp AND parent/guardian must alert camp nurse in writing within 7 days prior to the 1st day of camp. All medication needs to be administered by the nurse and kept in the office during camp.



INDIVIDUAL PLAN OF CARE

Any child with a special health care plan must have an individual plan of care form signed by the parent/guardian. The camp nurse will fill out the Plan of Care with parent/guardian within 7 days of the first day of camp.



FOOD

Campers may bring a snack daily for late morning snack time. Lunch is at noon for full day campers. Kindergartners also have a mid-afternoon snack time. All snacks and lunches must be nut-free. Water bottles are required.



CAMP REFUND

A full refund (less the \$50 deposit per session) will be issued if Wakeman Boys & Girls Club receives in writing your intent to withdraw before the final camp balances are due. No partial refund will be issued after this date except in case of illness or injury, in which case a doctor's note must be provided. Membership Director must receive notice of intent to withdraw by email before camp week starts. Allow 30 days for processing refund checks. Please visit wakemanclub.org/refunds to view our comprehensive policy. All memberships are non-refundable.

MEDICAMENTO

Cualquier niño con necesidades de medicamentos y/o alergias debe proporcionar al campamento una autorización firmada por su médico antes al comienzo del campamento Y el padre/tutor debe alertar al campamento enfermera por escrito antes del primer día de campamento. toda la medicación debe ser administrado por la enfermera y mantenerse en el oficina durante el campamento.

PLAN DE ATENCIÓN INDIVIDUAL

Cualquier niño con un cuidado de salud especial debe tener un plan de atención individual firmado por el padre/tutor. La enfermera del campamento completará el Plan de Cuidado.

COMIDA

Los campistas pueden traer una merienda todos los días para la hora de la merienda al final de la mañana. El almuerzo es al mediodía para los campistas de día completo. Los niños de kindergarten en Southport Clubhouse también tienen un refrigerio a media tarde. Todos los bocadillos y almuerzos deben ser libres de nueces. Se requieren botellas de agua.

POLÍTICA DE REEMBOLSO DEL CAMPAMENTO

Se emitirá un reembolso completo (menos una tarifa administrativa de \$50 por sesión) si Wakeman recibe por escrito su intención de retirarse antes de que los saldos finales del campamento venzan. No se emitirán reembolsos o créditos después de esta fecha a menos que sea una enfermedad o herida en ese caso se debe proporcionar la nota del médico. El director del Club debe recibir un aviso para retirarse por correo electrónico antes del comienzo de la semana del campamento. Por favor, siga los 30 días para procesar los cheques de reembolso.
