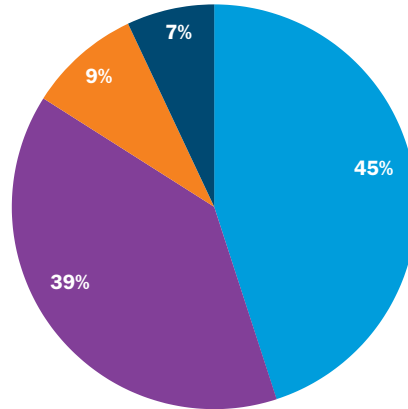

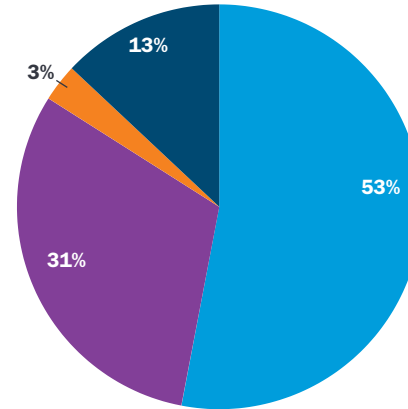

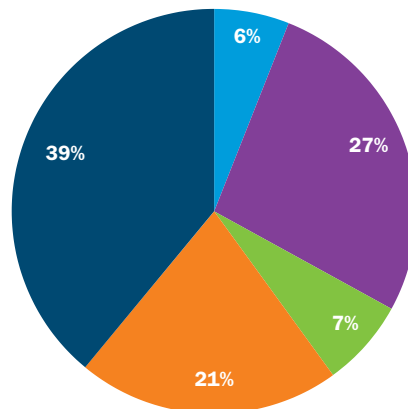

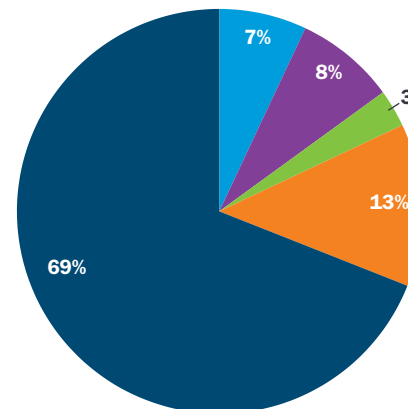

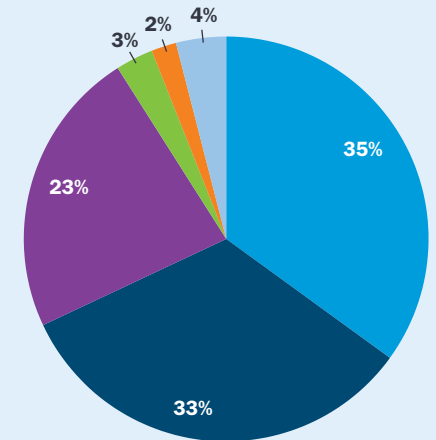

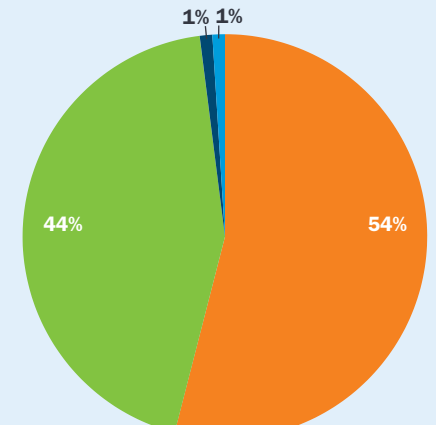

# FEATURE STORIES

## OPENING THE DOOR TO MORE MEMBERS

To increase our impact, we have updated our membership model for youth and teens. The cost of annual membership is now \$60, reduced from \$160, **opening our doors** to more families across our community. In addition to access to programs and events at all three Clubhouses, members can participate in Member Club Time events designed to provide a greater sense of community for kids, youth and their families.

## ALIGNING OUR PROGRAMS WITH OUR PILLARS

We build our programming around the **pillars we believe are crucial to building great futures**: Academic Success, Health & Wellbeing, Character & Leadership, and Life & Workforce Readiness. Examples include:

### Academic Success

Our DeLuca Early Learning Center at the Madison Avenue Clubhouse (MAC) is preparing preschoolers for elementary school by **developing foundational skills in language, literacy, motor skills, social-emotional development and problem-solving** in state-of-the-art, safe, indoor and outdoor classrooms. While all our youngest Club Kids are learning and growing each day, one student showed significant advancement. When he entered the program in February, he could only identify two letters. After receiving differentiated one on one instruction, as of May he can recognize all letters and letter sounds. He is continuing to thrive in the DeLuca Early Learning Center.

We've also enhanced our STEM programming and equipment at all three Clubhouses, including the official opening of our ASML STEM Lab & Makerspace at MAC, providing access to 3D printers, microscopes, robotics, drones and more.

### Health & Wellbeing

Ultramarathoner and friend of WBGC, Evan Titus, showed our Club Kids how training and dedication led to accomplishing an extraordinary goal. Evan ran 123 miles across the state of Connecticut to benefit WBGC. During his training, he visited the Southport Clubhouse, Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse, and Madison Avenue Community Clubhouse to share tips on **how to train your mind and body safely**. He hosted 0.5k mini marathons for our members, and they loved getting to cheer him on during his two-day ultramarathon! In addition to his run, Evan raised both awareness and \$15,000 to support WBGC's Healthy Lifestyles programming.



Evan remained involved with WBGC into Summer Camp. He joined our team as the Head Coach for the Race4Chase program, teaching our young campers about triathlons. WBGC is the first Boys & Girls Club in the state to participate in Race4Chase. For many of the 24 participants, this was their first time learning to swim and ride a bike. At the culmination of the program, our campers were able to compete in a triathlon along with 500 other campers statewide. The sense of pride and accomplishment was palpable! Evan Titus leads by example and has proven to be a strong mentor and coach to our Club Kids as they continue to commit to their own health & wellbeing.

### Character & Leadership

Our Youth of the Year program, the highest honor given by a Boys & Girls Club, expanded to include candidates from all three WBGC Clubhouses in 2025. This national Boys & Girls Club program has recognized young people for their **outstanding leadership, service, academic excellence, and dedication to health and wellbeing** for more than 75 years. Congratulations to our WBGC Youth of the Year Avery P. from our Southport Clubhouse, and Youth of the Year Finalists Oshane C. and Nathan P. from the Madison Avenue Community Clubhouse, Allison B. and Audrey P. from the Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse, and Peyton H. from the Southport Clubhouse.

### Life & Workforce Readiness

**WBGC teens are gaining the skills and experiences they need to be successful in future careers.** Programming and events helped to expose hundreds of youth and teens to careers in construction management and trades—paths which they might not otherwise explore—through programs like the ACE Mentoring Program, the Construction Junction, Keystone-led Career Fair, and our Careers in Trades Panels. The ACE Mentoring Program brings mentors from ACE companies together with students to complete a culminating architectural project over a 15-week period.

# 2025-2028 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

## 1. Organizational Strength

**Capital Planning and Facility Enhancements:** We have an intentional capital improvement plan in development, and significant facility enhancements completed and underway including a STEM Lab & Makers Space (MAC) and upgrades to the Red Baker and Warren gyms (Southport). With a focus on Governance, all capital projects are reviewed by a newly formed Board-led Committee.

**Funding:** With a sustainability focus, we are growing our resource development and diversifying our funding mix. We are adding the School Age Endorsement to our Early Learning Center license at our MAC and Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouses to access Care 4 Kids funding.

## 2. Talent

**Leadership & Staffing:** We have added a Chief Operating Officer and a Director of Sports, Health & Wellbeing to support our programming and operations, are promoting existing employees, and hold an annual all-staff training.

**Mental Health & Trauma-Informed Practices:** We are increasing our focus on trauma-informed education with a goal of 100% staff/volunteer participation in the current fiscal year.

## 3. Youth & Teen Impact

**Programming:** We utilize quality circles to ensure the highest caliber of programming in focus areas such as Summer Camp and our After School Program.

**Academic Success & STEAM:** We are integrating STEAM initiatives and nature-based STEAM programming through partnerships including ASML, Aspetuck Land Trust, Apple and others.

**Leadership & Workforce Development:** Our College Fairs, Multicultural Fair, Construction Junction, Keystone Club (Gold Status), Torch Summit (300 youth), and financial literacy programming will continue to provide life & workforce readiness.

**Health and Wellbeing:** Through partnerships and programming, we're continuing to build our Health and Wellbeing offerings, including our Race4Chase Youth Triathlon program, Midnight Basketball with the Bridgeport Police Department, Wakeman BGC Cowboys football, and more. The Red Baker Basketball League for grades 9-12 saw a record number of 273 participants.

## 4. Influence

**Our Board of Trustees:** Our focus is to recruit, retain, and engage members of our Board of Trustees that provide experience and skills, and that reflect community diversity.

## 5. Digital Transformation

We are streamlining data collection, are using best practices for audit, surveys and grant reporting, and launched a new mobile registration application.



# THE YEAR IN REVIEW

## BUILDING GREAT FUTURES TOGETHER

The generous support of our partners and sponsors has made it possible for Wakeman Boys & Girls Club to expand its reach and depth of services and opportunities.

A focus on collaborations has also helped WBGC expand its influence and impact, including programs with schools, local government, corporations, and fellow non-profit organizations.

### AUGUST 2024

Through our partnership with ASML, our Madison Avenue Clubhouse (MAC) summer campers had the opportunity to talk to NASA astronaut Dr. Jeanette Epps LIVE from the International Space Station! Aligned with our mission to provide **exposure to STEM themes and careers**, campers asked Epps questions about her career and experiences in space.



### OCTOBER 2024

Our DeLuca Early Learning Center opened at MAC and **welcomed its first students ages 3-5!** We also officially launched our new ASML STEM Lab & Makerspace at MAC, **providing access to STEM resources**, including 3D printers, laser engraver printers, microscopes, robotics kits, and drones.



### DECEMBER 2024

As part of our Life & Workforce Readiness programming, teen Club members graduated from our Finance Lab, sponsored by Webster Bank in partnership with Ankorz Up. The ongoing program focuses on building the **skills required for financial literacy and empowerment**. The graduation included the presentation of Time Capsule projects which will be reopened in five years.



### SEPTEMBER 2024

We launched our **first annual free Bridgeport Day For Kids for the entire community**, in partnership with Bridgeport Caribe Youth Leaders and Southwest Community Health Center. The day featured athletics, program showcases, STEM activities, food trucks and more!

### NOVEMBER 2024

Our popular **basketball program expanded** at our Southport (SPT) and Smilow-Burroughs (SBC) Clubhouses to include first and second graders, with a new Developmental Basketball League.

### JANUARY 2025

The Kindness is Free Organization, powered by the Boys & Girls Club of West San Gabriel Valley and East Side, visited all three of our Clubhouses and McKinley School Site to experience the implementation of their **curriculum, focused on compassion, inclusivity and respect**.

### FEBRUARY 2025

Our annual Fine Arts Exhibition held at our SPT Clubhouse, *Express Yourself: Imagination Unbound*, featured works of art from Members across all sites and **celebrated the power of individuality and imagination**. Selected works competed in the Boys & Girls Clubs of America's National Arts Contest.



### APRIL 2025

The Southport Clubhouse hosted the annual Northeast Regional Torch Club Summit, with more than 270 teens and advisors from Boys & Girls Clubs across the Northeast in attendance. Teens engaged in meaningful conversations and workshops, **shared experiences, and explored opportunities for Club and personal growth**.



### JUNE 2025

Our annual Midnight Basketball program, a partnership with the Bridgeport Police, provided youth across Bridgeport and Fairfield with a **safe space for youth** on Friday nights. Additionally, the WBGC/COBRA high school rugby team won the Rugby CT D1AA State Championship!



### MARCH 2025

Our Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse kicked off a series of Family Engagement nights, designed to **bring families and the greater community together**. Monthly activities included bowling, art, and a scavenger hunt.

### MAY 2025

**Partnerships with a range of companies**, including Apple, Turner and Comcast, enhanced STEM learning, workforce readiness, and the physical appearance of our Clubhouses. Additionally, Justin W., a teen and pianist from our Southport Clubhouse, was selected to perform at the BGCA National Conference!

### JULY 2025

The WBGC Cowboys Tackle Football team had the opportunity to meet and train with the New York Giants, providing an unforgettable experience focused on **character, leadership, and athletic excellence**.

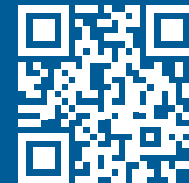
