Minimum Qualifications (Nominee should meet at least 3 of the following):

- 10+ years of service or involvement with the organization (staff, volunteer, board member, alum, etc.)
- Demonstrated impact on lives of youth, families, or the community through their involvement
- A proven commitment to the mission and values of the organization
- Recognized as a role model or mentor to youth or peers
- Shown leadership in advancing the organizations programs, events, or initiatives

Preferred Credentials (These strengthen a nomination but are not required):

- Developed or held innovative programs or initiatives that benefited youth
- Served in a long-term leadership role (i.e. board chair, program director, etc.)
- Advocated for youth of the organization in the community, public sector or media
- Contributed philanthropically or played a significant role in fundraising
- Maintains a continued connection or legacy with the organization even after official involvement ended

Distinguished Considerations (Exceptional qualities that may merit special recognition):

- Lifelong dedication to youth development, social justice, or community advancement
- Inspired others to support or join the organization
- Received awards of honors from credible institutions for work in youth services
