MEMBERSHIP

A current membership is required to participate in any program or Open Rec/Open Gym drop in.

Memberships are valid for one year (365 days) from the day of purchase or renewal date. If a membership expires during a program, the member is required to renew membership to participate in all program meeting dates.

Note: Membership is available to all K-12th graders regardless of their age or town of residence and is valid at our Southport Clubhouse, Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse and Madison Avenue Clubhouse. OPEN REC

(Known as Open Gym at Southport Clubhouse):

Time set aside for members in 3rd-12th grade to use the facility on a drop-in basis. K-2nd graders may not participate in Open Rec. Hours vary by season. Adults are not permitted in Open Gym. Visit wakemanclub.org for monthly schedules.

WBGC PROGRAMS AT SCHOOLS

McKinley Elementary School (Fairfield)	The Before School Program at McKinley is available 7:00am-8:45am. The After School Program is available 3:15-6:00pm. As a 21st Century Community Learning Center and recipient of other grants, the McKinley ASP is available free to many youth, and low fee for other youth. Available to McKinley students only.
Holland Hill Elementary School (Fairfield)	The Great Futures Mentoring Program is offered on Tuesdays at Holland Hill, with 20 mentees matched 1 on 1 in a group setting with teen volunteer mentors for support in academics, physical activity, play and social skills. The Mentoring Program at Holland Hill is supported by the Kiwanis Club of Fairfield.

EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS - AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

All sites open at 1:00pm on school early dismissal days for members enrolled in the After School Program. Clubhouse sites do not open early when schools close early due to weather or other unexpected circumstances. More details are available at wakemanclub.org.

REGISTRATION/WITHDRAWAL

After School Program registration can be completed anytime during the school year, space permitting. Families who wish to withdraw from ASP are required to give two weeks' notice by email to the clubhouse's Membership Director.

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM TIERED PRICING

We understand families have differing abilities to pay for programs, so to make the Club more accessible for all, we offer a tiered pricing system for our After School Program, School's Out Program, and Summer Camp. Please choose the tier most fitting for your family. All members will have the same experience with their peers regardless of which tier a family selects. Tier selections are confidential and can be selected online. Families should understand Tier A is the base parent fee charged for program; families should pay this price if they can. ASP rates do not include days off from school and are not prorated based on missed days, Club closures, vacation days or snow. They do include school early dismissal days. Our School's Out Program is available on scheduled vacation days (fee applies). Tiered fees for the Before School Program at McKinley School are available at wakemanclub.org.

^{*}All WBGC fees are subsidized as a primary focus of our mission to give access to all. The full fee price will come up on your registration, but when you select your tier, you will only be responsible for the parent fee portion. Those who may qualify for Care4Kids will be required to complete a Care4Kids application if not already registered for C4K. This helps WBGC continue to support subsidizing our fees to keep the cost down. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.

Tier Guide

TIER A* - The full parent pay rate charged for this program, which is subsidized by WBGC, donors and other 3rd parties. If you are able to pay this amount, please do so.

TIER B* - A more substantial financial assistance rate for families who are financially challenged. If you are unable to afford Tier A, please pay this amount.

TIER C* - Thanks to our generous donors, we can provide some additional funding especially due to employment layoffs, families eligible for free lunch, or unforeseen circumstances. If you are unable to afford Tier A or B, please pay this amount.

Those unable to afford full membership or Tier C of After School Program should submit a completed financial aid application to the Membership Director at least two weeks prior to registration date, when possible.

Wakeman Boys & Girls Club's after-school program, serving 5 through 12-year-olds, is exempt from State of CT childcare licensure as per the Office of Early Childhood. All WBGC programs adhere to the membership and safety standards set forth by Boys & Girls Club of America.

^{**}All families who select Tier B or C may be required to complete a Care4Kids application to the state of CT to assist WBGC in recouping childcare expenses. Some families who select Tier A may also be required to complete a Care4Kids application, based on the family's stated household income and family size during program enrollment. An income guide is available on our website.

Vacation Days (School's Out Program) **Grades K-8**

Join us on your day off from school for organized games, challenges, sports, art, STEM and other activities. Members may be dropped off/picked up any time. Members have supervised free play options from 8:00-9:00am and 5:30-6:00pm. Structured activities begin at 9:00am and end at 5:30pm.

Members should bring nut-free snacks for morning and afternoon snack and a nut-free lunch and a refillable water bottle. Southport Clubhouse Only: Add lunch of 2 pizza slices, potato chips and a juice for \$8 to any School's Out Day. Pizza must be pre-ordered through WBGC online registration portal.

The DeLuca Early Learning Center operates as a full-day program from 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM. Weekly tuition fees will be determined on a sliding scale. Basketball Leagues, Clinics, & Challenges

JUNIOR BASKETBALL LEAGUE

Grades: 6-8 | Fee: \$115 Dates: February 5 - April 11 **Location: Southport Clubhouse**

Boys Junior League is the exciting place where 6th, 7th and 8th graders choose to play in a structured environment while learning the game and developing team skills and concepts. While traditionally a league for boys, girls are welcome too! Each grade group is scheduled to play in separate divisions however two grades may be combined based on registration. Players are assigned to a team that practices one night during the week (Monday-Friday based on participant's availability) and play one game each weekend. Teams play a 7-game regular season and then a single elimination playoff to crown a champion in each division. Teams are coached by parent and other volunteer coaches who have completed WBGC Safety Trainings. Smilow-Burroughs Club teams will play in a join league with the Southport Clubhouse. SBC teams are expected to play the majority of their games at SBC.

School-Based Programs & Mentoring

MCKINLEY & HOLLAND HILL ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Since 2005, Wakeman Boys & Girls Club has provided after school enrichment and mentoring programs for elementary students and volunteer opportunities for high school students. Through these after-school programs, McKinley and Holland Hill students connect with consistent role models, strengthen their academic skills, and socialize with peers. Teen volunteers develop patience and connection as they support youth and give back to the community.

The McKinley Program provides Before School Program daily from 7:00-8:45am and After School Program daily 3:15-6:00pm. The After School Program incorporates numerous high yield learning experiences in academics, Art, STEM, play and mentoring, including through partnerships with Apple and Mystic Aquarium. The Program at McKinley is a 21st Century Community Learning Center.

The Holland Hill Program provides small group mentoring to 20 youth mentees, once weekly at school. Holland Hill students may also ride the bus to the Southport Clubhouse After School Program.
