Parent/Guardian Membership Agreement

I/we hereby certify my/our child is physically able to participate in all programs offered by Wakeman Memorial Association, Inc., commonly known as "Wakeman Boys & Girls Club" and referred in this agreement as "WBGC".

In consideration of this application being accepted by WBGC, I/we do hereby waive and release, for myself/ourselves, my/our heirs, executors, administrators or representatives and for my/our child and his/her heirs, executors administrators, or representatives, any and all rights or claims for damages or other relief that I/we or he/she may have against the Wakeman Memorial Association, Inc. or its authorized agents, for any and all injuries that may be suffered by my/our child as a result of his/her participation in any or all of the Club's programs.

I/we further agree that our child shall accept and abide by the direction, instruction and authority of WBGC appointees, staff and coaches. I/we further agree that our child shall respect the rights and privileges of others and abide by the rules and courtesies of fair play and sportsmanship.

I/we further agree to accept full responsibility for all WBGC equipment or uniforms as may be issued or lent to my/our child pursuant to his/her participation in the above and I/we shall compensate WBGC for any loss, destruction or damage to such equipment or uniforms.

I/we give permission for my/our child to be transported by bus or van or walking group under WBGC staff supervision for program related field trips and activities.

I/we understand:

- Violation of any of terms or provisions of this application may result in suspension or expulsion from participation.
- WBGC sponsored activities and participants may be photographed or videotaped, and I hereby consent to use of my child's picture and likeness for WBGC related promotional purpose without further consideration.
- As a WBGC member, my child will have access to the Internet. While precautions are taken, it is possible he/she may access inappropriate sites. WBGC has rules and consequences at the Club for such behavior; however, the Club will not be responsible for the consequences of such access to inappropriate material by members.
- In case of emergency, WBGC will seek emergency medical treatment for my child if I cannot be reached. I will be responsible for any/all costs of medical attention and treatment.
- WBGC may collect information via online or written surveys, questionnaires, interviews, focus groups and membership applications. Results of these analyses may be shared with WBGC staff, Boys & Girls Clubs of America, funders and other community stakeholders to evidence Club/program/member effectiveness and impact.
- WBGC is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Parents/members are responsible for their own transportation to and from WBGC.
- WBGC is a drop-in facility, meaning members have ability to come to, and leave Club as they wish. It is parent's responsibility to discuss their expectations with their own child. WBGC staff provides a safe, secure Club, but WBGC is not responsible for children who choose to leave the Club or premises with/without parent permission.
- WBGC's after-school program, serving 6 through 12-year old's, is exempt from State of Connecticut childcare licensure as per CT Office of Early Childhood. All WBGC programs adhere to membership and safety standards set forth by Boys & Girls Clubs of America.
- State of Connecticut - Office of Early Childhood COVID-19 Informed Consent I hereby attest that I have been informed of the following pertaining to the coronavirus: People who are 65 years and older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions or are at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 are recommended to stay at home. A list of medical conditions associated with a higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 can be found in CDC's guidance(*). THIS DOCUMENT AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND IS LEGALLY BINDING. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT YOU ARE RELEASING WAKEMAN BOYS & GIRLS CLUB FROM ALL LIABILITY AND FOREVER GIVING UP ANY CLAIMS THEREFOR. Assumption of Risk I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of the child named below ("Minor"), acknowledge and agree that any use of Wakeman Boys & Girls Club facilities, services, equipment and premises ("Facilities") and any participation in Wakeman Boys & Girls Club programs and activities ("Programs") comes with inherent risks including, but in no way limited to: (1) moderate and severe personal injury, (2) property damage, (3) disability, (4) death, and (5) sickness or disease. I voluntarily, for myself and Minor, accept and assume full responsibility for these risks as well as any and all other risks of the use of Facilities and participation in Programs. I agree that I have full knowledge of the nature and extent of all such risks and am not relying on all such risks being described in this document. Waiver, Release, Indemnification & Covenant Not to Sue In consideration of Minor's use of Facilities and participation in Programs I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor that Wakeman Boys & Girls Club, its officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers, insurers and representatives ("Releasees") will not be liable for any personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease incurred by Minor, however occurring including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees. I understand that Minor and I will be solely responsible for any loss or damage, including personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease sustained from the use of Facilities and participation in Programs. I further agree, in my legal capacity as the parent/guardian of Minor, on behalf of Minor, myself, and any and all legal successors and proxies, to release and HEREBY DO RELEASE, WAIVE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE Releasees from any causes of action, claims, suits, liabilities or demands of any nature whatsoever including, but in no way limited to, claims of negligence, which Minor, myself, and any and all legal successors and proxies may have, now or in the future, against Releasees on account of personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness, disease or accident of any kind, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities or participation in Programs, whether that participation is supervised or unsupervised, however the injury or damage occurs, including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees. In further consideration of the use of Facilities and participation in Programs, I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Releasees from any and all causes of

action, claims, demands, losses, suits, liabilities or costs of any nature whatsoever, including claims of negligence, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities and participation in Programs.
